- Convene neighborhood meetings to help identify priorities for additional programs
- Serve as community contacts and partners for federal and philanthropic grants
- Ambassadors recruited to increase participation from specific neighborhoods, and provided resources for hosting neighborhood meetings w/ Office of Climate Action & other City departments
