Dual Primary – Voter Required to Choose Democratic or Republican Ballot

The June 10 Primary is a “dual primary” meaning it is two elections held on the same day. Virginia Election Law:

- Prohibits the voter from voting in both primaries.
- Requires the voter to openly choose a Democratic or Republican Ballot at the time of presenting his/herself to vote.
- Does not provide for political party registration, therefore this choice does not “register” the voter with the Democratic or Republican Party.

Deadline for In-person Absentee Voting:

Saturday, June 7

Mail Absentee Ballot Return Deadline:

June 10, 7:00 p.m.

Postmarks are not considered.

Absentee Ballots may also be dropped at the Voter Registration Office prior to 7:00 p.m. on Election Day, June 10. *An absentee ballot dropped off, must be delivered personally by the voter.*

In-person Voting: at 132 North Royal St. weekdays 8 to 5 and on Saturday, June 7
