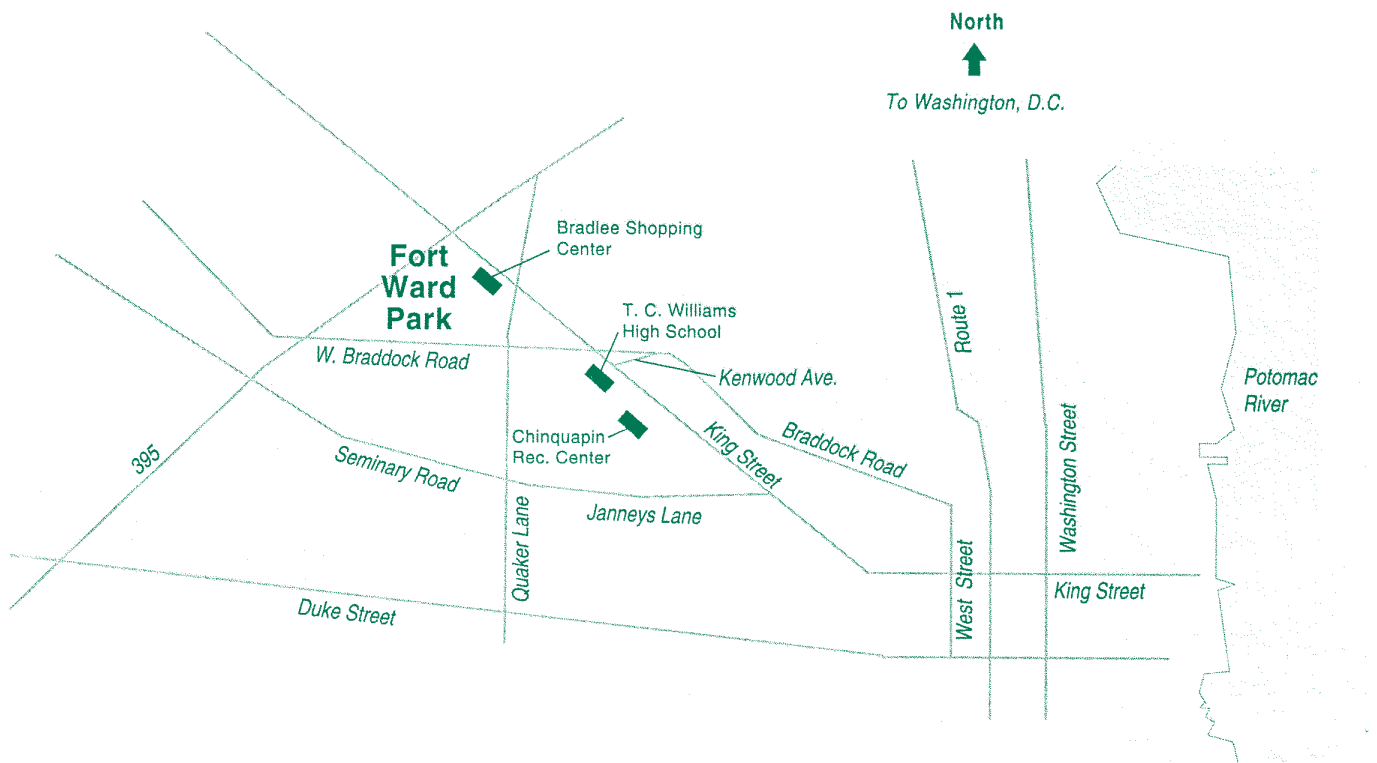
Fort Ward Park – 4301 W. Braddock Road

From 395: Turn east at Seminary Road exit, following Seminary to fourth traffic light (Alexandria Hospital). Turn left onto North Howard Street; proceed to West Braddock. Turn right and park entrance is on the left.

From downtown Alexandria: Follow King Street west to T.C. Williams High School (3330 King Street). Turn right onto Kenwood Avenue for one block and then turn left onto West Braddock Road. Follow West Braddock Road for 3/4 mile and park entrance is on the right.
