Videos Made by Alexandria Youth Depict the Realities of Adolescent Pregnancy

Teens of Promise, Community Lodgings, and Wholistic Family Agape Institute were the first, second, and third place winners, respectively, of the Alexandria Campaign on Adolescent Pregnancy's (ACAP) Undiscovered Reality Video contest. Alexandria youth ages 12 to 19 were asked to create videos depicting the reality of teen pregnancy and related issues. ACAP received seven videos and each was judged on clarity, creativity, content, and production. The winners were announced at the ACAP Call to Action Breakfast on April 1.
