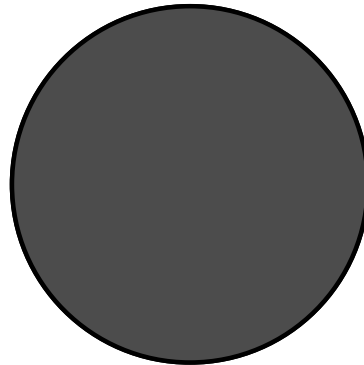

I-395 COMMUTER CHOICE GRANTS

I-395 COMM. CHOICE GRANTS

1.) DASH West End – Pentagon Service Enhancements (Line 35)

- Continuation of current FY 22 – FY 23 improvements
- Up to \$7.5 million requested over two-year period.

2.) West End – Mark Center Service Enhancements (Line 36A/B)

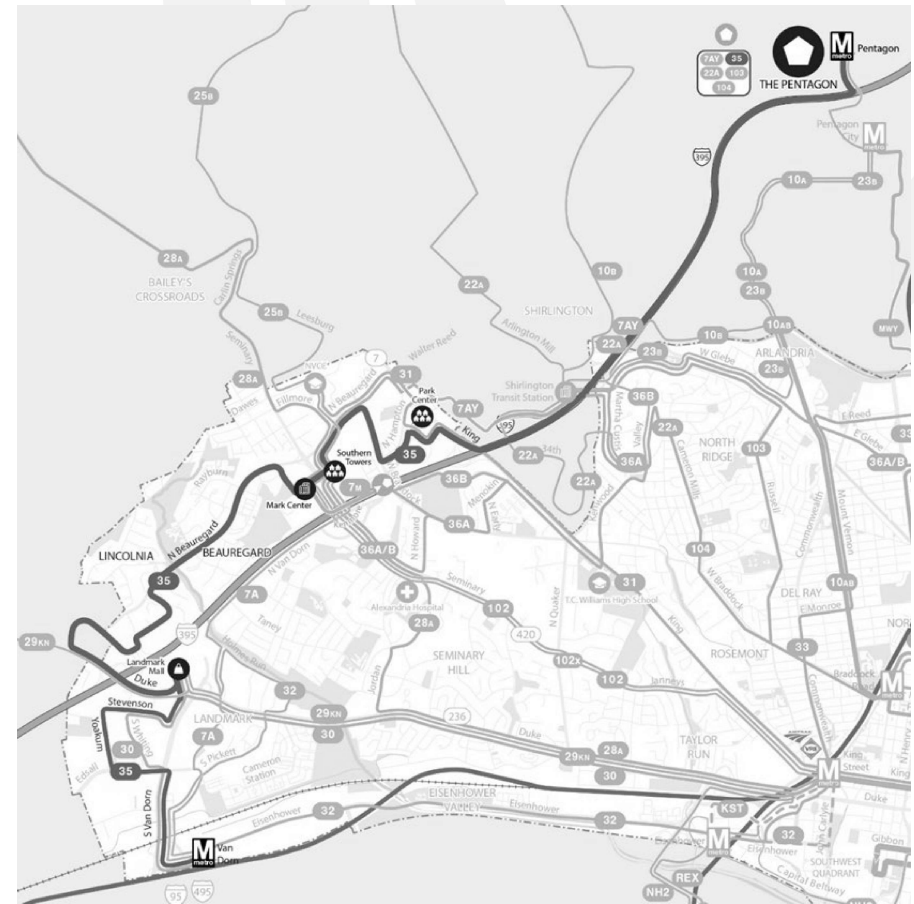
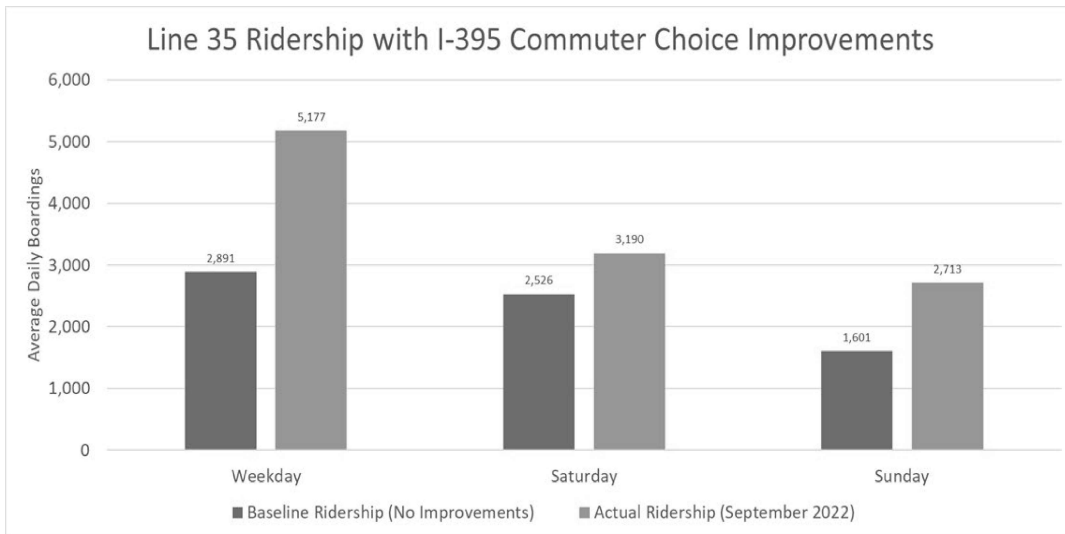
- Continuation of current FY 22 – FY 23 improvements
- Up to \$4 million requested over two-year period.

3.) Bus Purchases for Add'l Capacity from West End to Pentagon

- Funds purchase of 10 electric buses for added Line 35 capacity.
- Up to \$15 million requested.

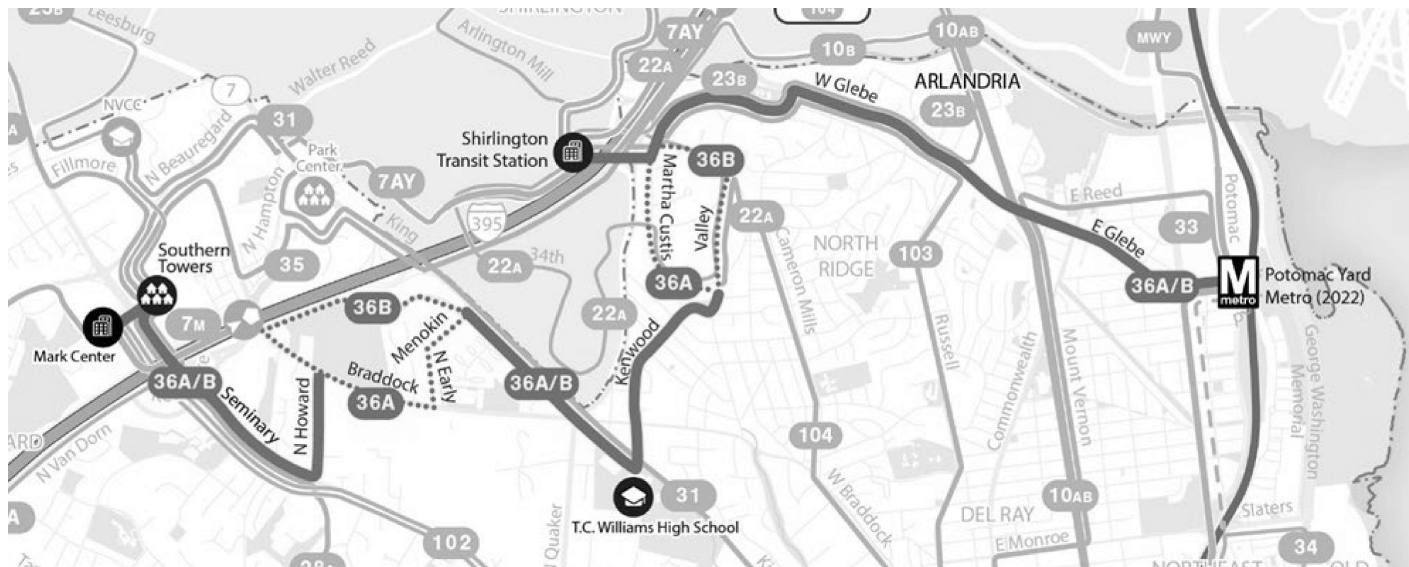
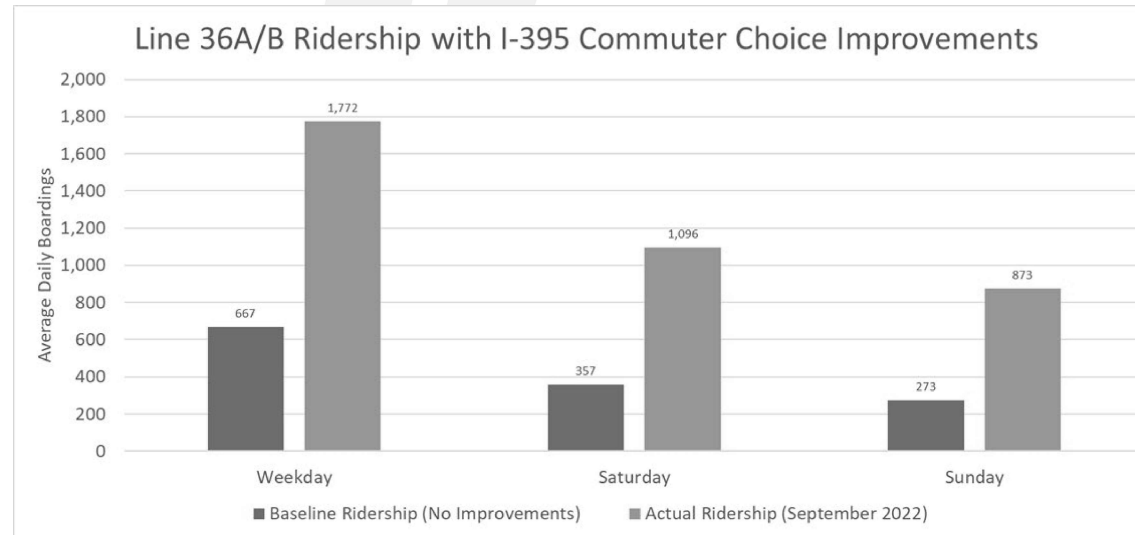
LINE 35 WEST END - PENTAGON

- Van Dorn to Pentagon via Beauregard
- Current I-395 funding allows route to run every 10 minutes on weekdays and every 15 minutes on weekends.



LINE 36A/B WEST END – MARK CENTER

- Mark Center to Potomac Yard
- Current I-395 funding allows route to run every 15 minutes, 7 days per week.

FY 2024 DRPT State Aid Request

Operating Assistance (up to \$34,000,000)

- State awards a portion for general operating expenses
- Typically, 20-30% reimbursement

Capital Assistance (up to \$20,000,000)

- Bus and parts replacement to maintain SGR
- Typically, 60-68% reimbursement

Commuter Assistance Program (up to \$331,300)

- Go Alex staffing and programming
- 20% local match required

Demonstration Projects (up to \$315,000)

- Electric Bus Charge, Management System Pilot
- Automated Wheelchair Securement Pilot
- 20% local match required

Public Transportation Workforce Development (up to \$55,000)

- Intern
- 20% local match required

- That the Transportation Commission move to provide a letter of endorsement to City Council for FY 2024 DRPT State Aid Program Grant Applications through DRPT and NVTC
