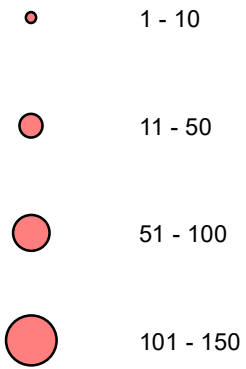


# 2022 Committed Affordable Rental Housing in the City of Alexandria (Constructed and Under Construction)

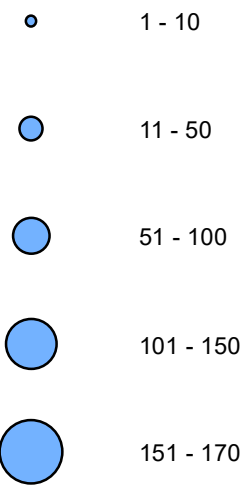

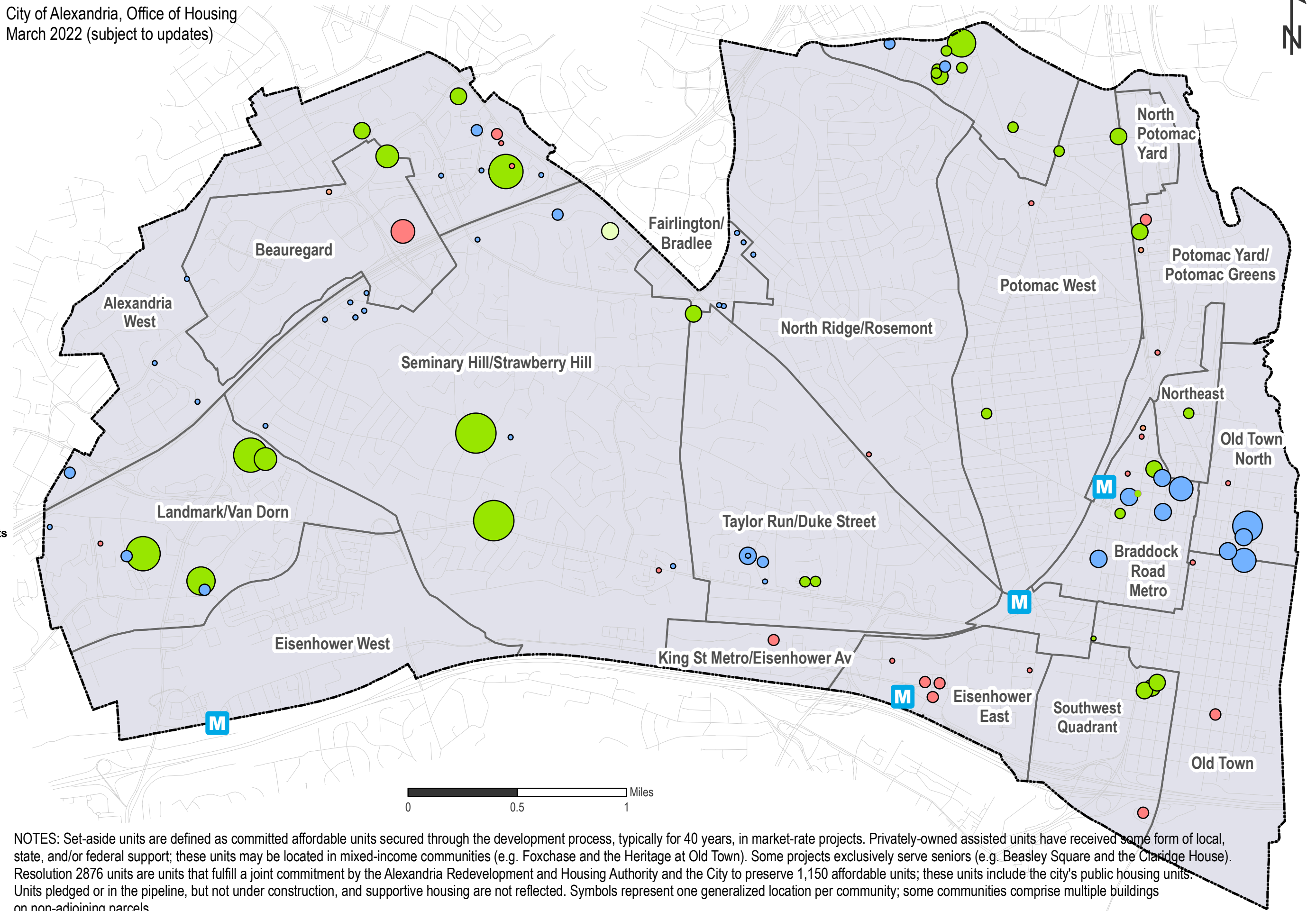
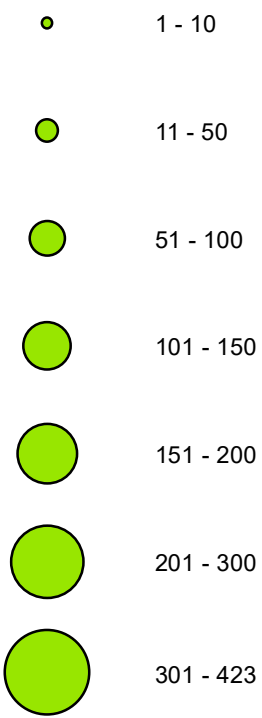

## Privately-owned Assisted Units



NOTES: Set-aside units are defined as committed affordable units secured through the development process, typically for 40 years, in market-rate projects. Privately-owned assisted units have received some form of local, state, and/or federal support; these units may be located in mixed-income communities (e.g. Foxchase and the Heritage at Old Town). Some projects exclusively serve seniors (e.g. Beasley Square and the Claridge House). Resolution 2876 units are units that fulfill a joint commitment by the Alexandria Redevelopment and Housing Authority and the City to preserve 1,150 affordable units; these units include the city's public housing units. Units pledged or in the pipeline, but not under construction, and supportive housing are not reflected. Symbols represent one generalized location per community; some communities comprise multiple buildings on non-adjointing parcels.
