

#### Regional Roadway Safety Program (RRSP) Supports projects that will lead to a reduction in fatal



- Recommended "enhanced bicycle facility" in Alexandria Mobility Plan
- ➢Connects to existing bicycle facility, dense multi-family housing, commercial retail, and Duke Street Transitway
- Project would include planning, community engagement, and conceptual design



Pedestrian Lighting Improvements Study (\$80,000)


- Approximately 25% of pedestrian crashes that occur in darkness result in fatal or severe injury
- Study to evaluate lighting best practices, evaluate key areas for lighting needs, and develop lighting recommendations
