The project is on track for substantial completion by July 30, 2023. **Stephen Beggs** stated that the Potomac Yard Metro is scheduled to open on May 19. There are a few park areas that need to be returned to their original condition. **Geoffrey Goode** was not in attendance.

**DISTRICT III: Katy Matthews** gave an update on Minnie Howard. There will be an announcement involving programming for grades 9-12. The programming will have a heavy focus on STEM. She recently participated in a Safe Routes to School audit which focused on ensuring safety for children that may walk or ride bikes to the Minnie Howard campus. **David Brennan** did not attend the last youth sports advisory group meeting and deferred to Beth Znidersic for an update. Beth stated that there was a good discussion about the renovations to Simpson Park. Community engagement regarding the renovations includes yesterday's pop-up event, and a community meeting scheduled for this Wednesday. To date, there have been over 330 responses to the online survey. **Phillip Voorhees** was not in attendance.
