UTILITY WORK NOTICE – June 2024

100 Block of Hume Ave. & E. Raymond Ave.

This notice is to inform City of Alexandria Residents in the immediate proximity of the 100 block of Hume Ave. and E. Raymond Ave. that utility test pit work is scheduled to be performed in the area to support Flood Action Alexandria capital improvement projects to help mitigate flooding in the project areas.

The City has hired a contractor to collect information on the City's storm sewer system and streetscape in support of the 100 Hume Ave. Stormdrain Bypass Project.

The utility test pit work is scheduled to begin and end the week of June 17th, 2024, weather permitting. Work will occur during standard allowable construction work hours and is expected to take no more than three full workdays. The contractor crews will operate drilling equipment to confirm the depth and location of utility mains within the proposed work areas. The contractor operations will not take place outside of existing City noise and construction ordinances that require:

Construction work in the City of Alexandria is permitted from 7:00AM to 6:00PM Monday – Friday, and 9:00AM – 5:00PM on Saturday. No construction activity is permitted on Sundays.

No disturbances or impacts will be made to your private property.

Parking lane closures and traffic pattern adjustments are scheduled along and around the 100 block of Hume Ave. and E. Raymond Ave. on June 17th through June 23rd, 2024, to support these efforts. Access to residential driveways within the work area will be maintained; however, street parking within the work area will be restricted for the duration of work. Lane closure signs will be posted the day before operations begin. Please relocate any street parked vehicles prior to the start of work.

As always, please be mindful of contractor crews working in or alongside the roadway.
