
BEN BRENMAN STORMWATER POND WEIR WALLS

The weir walls help slow the water down and settle pollutants that can be harmful to wildlife and plants (there is a second weir wall located under the longer pedestrian bridge).

This weir wall separates the forebay from the main pond – much like a wall in your home separating rooms.

More often than not you will see a lot of wildlife hanging out around the weir wall. What can you see there today?














This tour highlights how the forebay,
