

### Public Hearing: Consideration of Grant Application to the I-395 Commuter Choice Program




## I-395 Commuter Choice Grant Program

- NVTC program that distributes toll revenue from I-395 Express Lanes to projects that help reduce SOV travel on the corridor.
- DASH currently receiving \$5.5 million per year in FY24 FY25 for enhanced, high -frequency service on Lines 35 and 36A/B
- Proposing to extend current projects in FY26 -27
  - PRIORITY #1- Line 35 Enhancements (West End Pentagon) \$8M
  - PRIORITY #2- Line 36 Enhancements (West End Potomac Yard \$5M
  - Requesting funding for up to \$13 million (\$6.5 million per year.)





# Action Item: FY 2026 City Budget



## FY26 Budget

- City Manager seeking Boards and Commission input by Nov 1
- Focus Areas:
  - Navigating financial sustainability of CIP
  - Employee compensation, race and equity social initiatives, public safety programs, and investment in education
  - Stabilize affordable housing
  - Diversification of taxbase
  - Reduce required borrowing and associated debt
- Feedback provided at this meeting will be incorporated by staff into a letter to be signed by the Chair



### Review of FY25 TC Budget Priorities

- 1) Ensuring continuous and sustainable WMATA regional transit service
- 2) Implementing the **Transit Vision Plan**, with more **DASH** and a focus on **regional connectivity**
- 3) Staffing and resources for Complete Streets and Safe Routes to School, including more protected bike infrastructure to make biking feasible for more people for short trips
- 4) Fully repairing and maintaining Alexandria's multi use trail system in a state of good repair, for many people rely on it just as others do the road.
