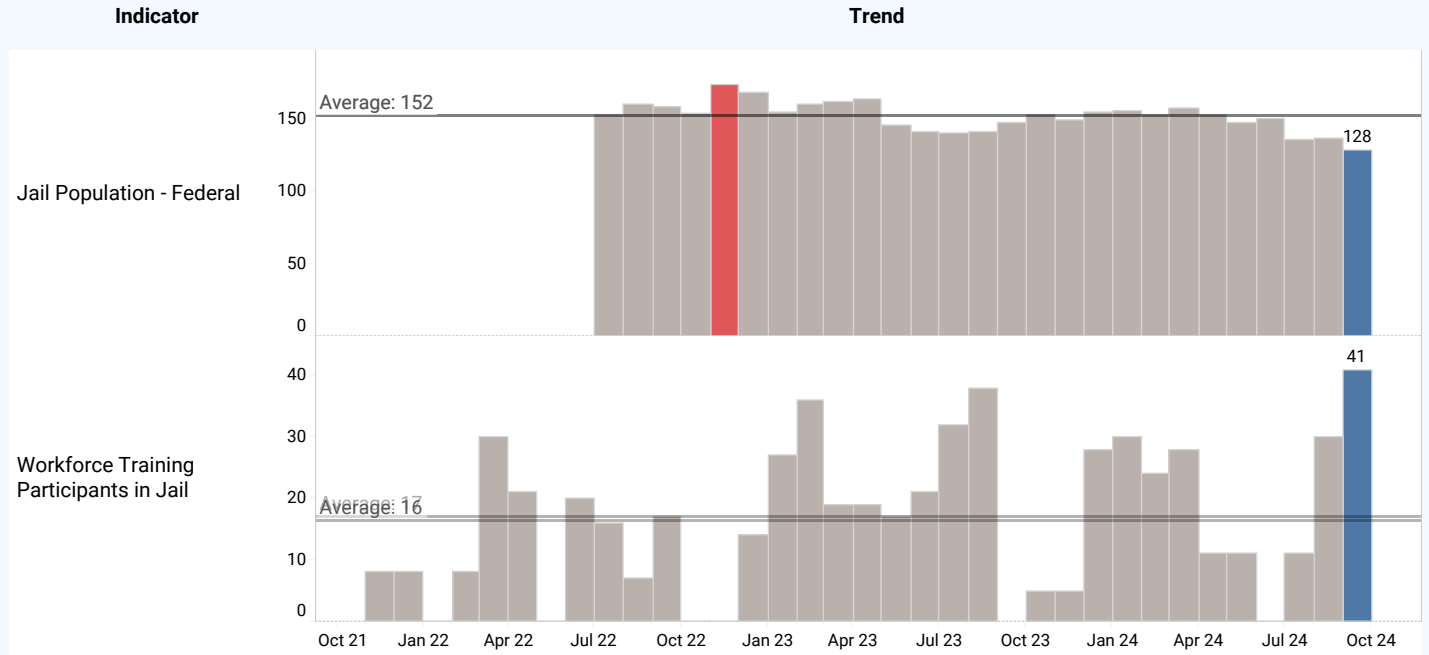

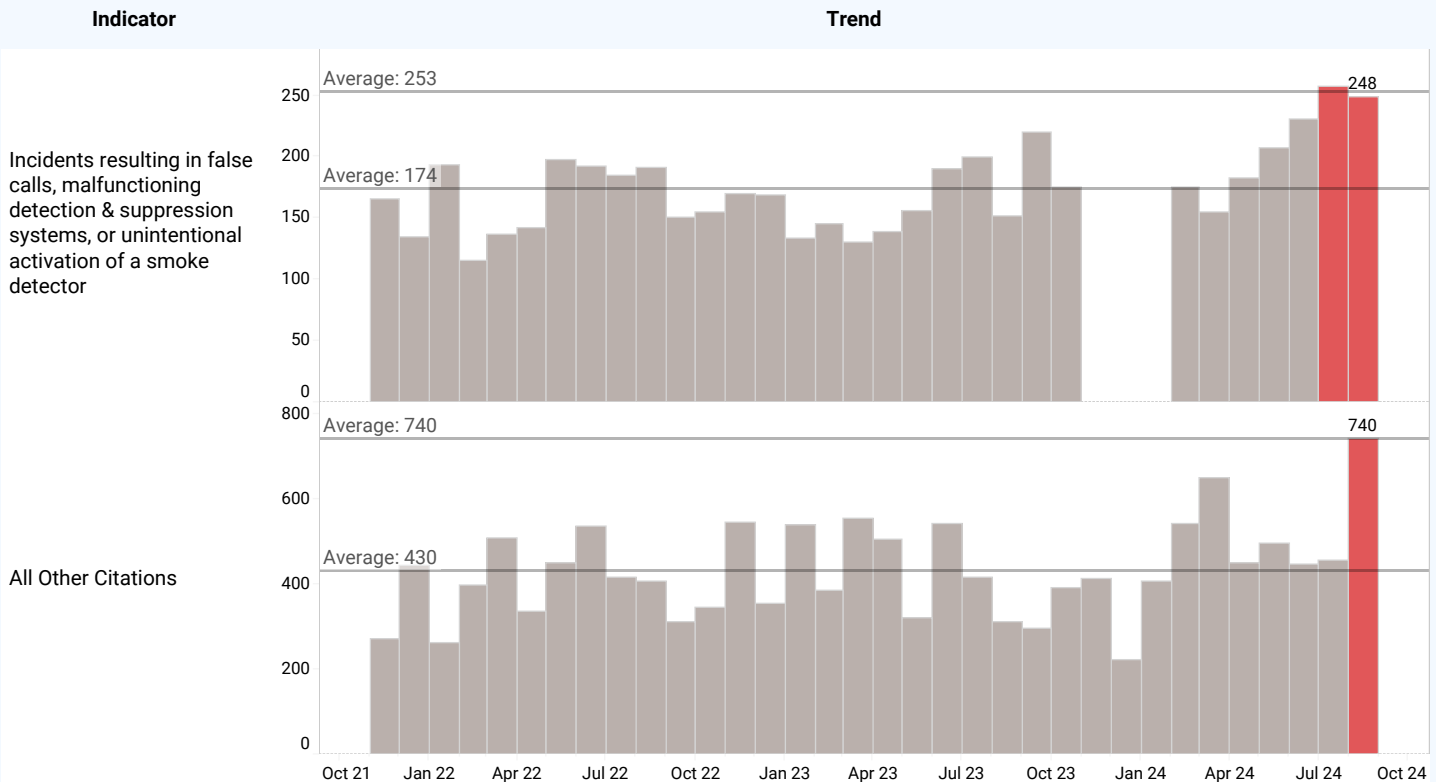
Indicators that were significantly different during the previous months from their average from data available from the past 3 years

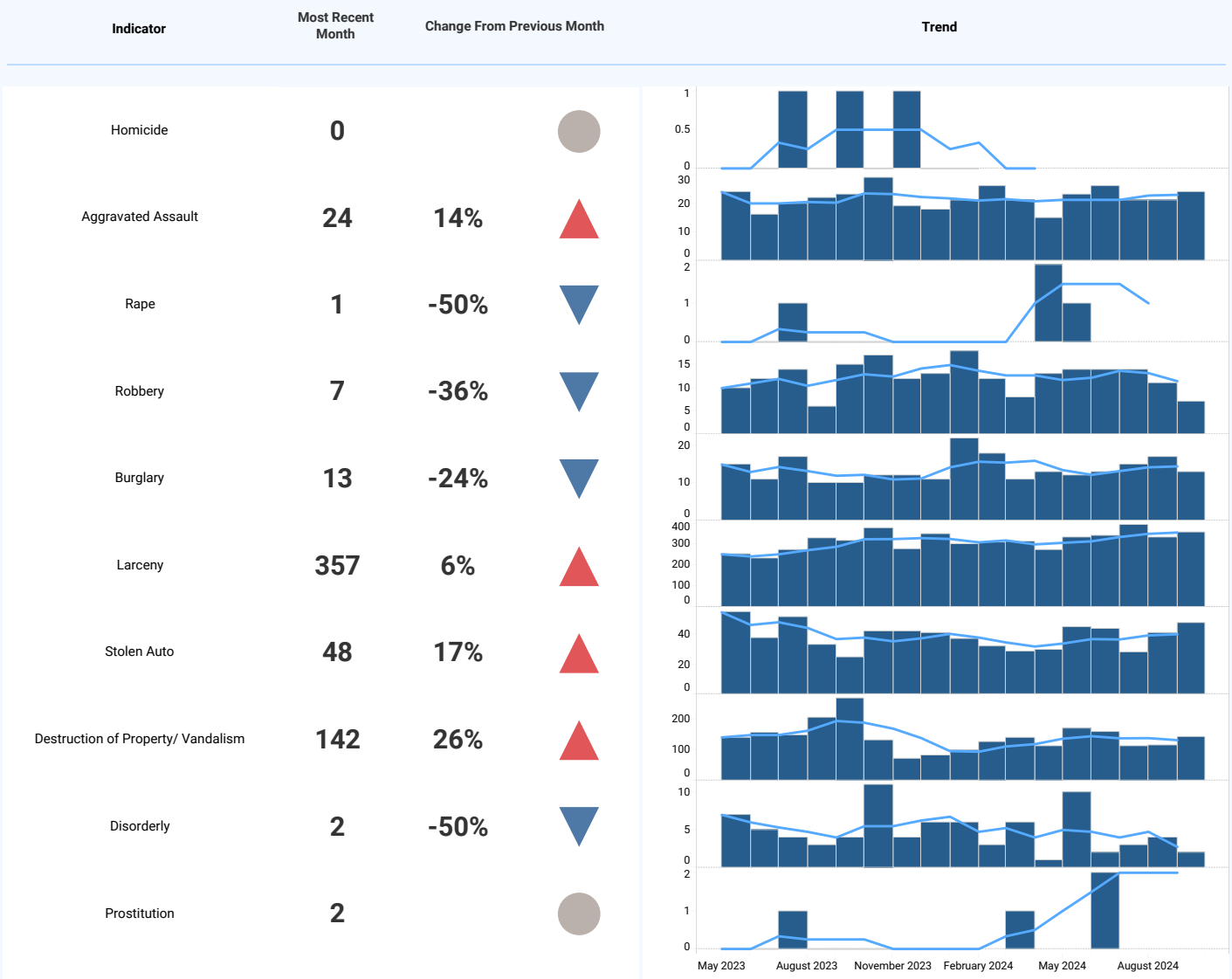

### Crime Year to Date Situational Awareness



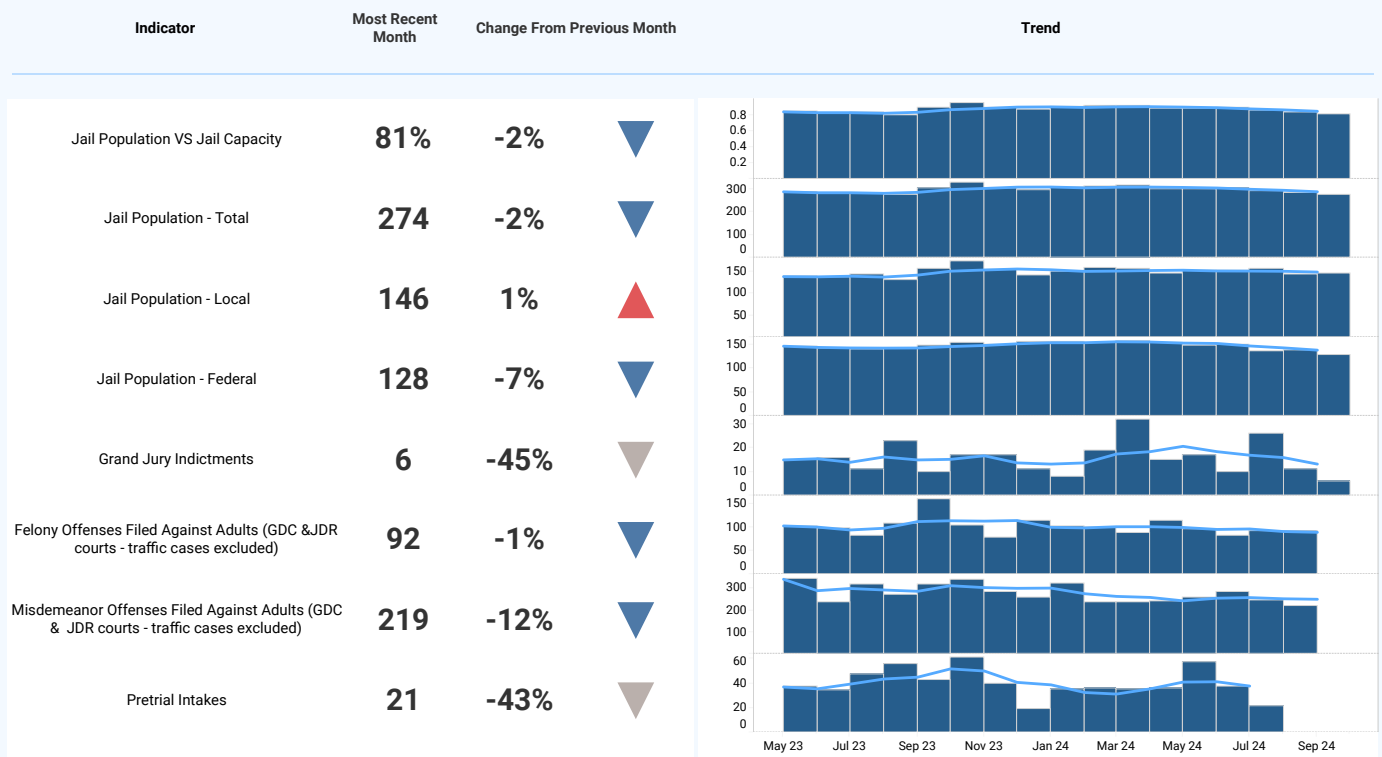
