

FY 2031CMAQ / RSTP Application





Federal & State Funding

Congestion Mitigation & Air Quality (CMAQ)

- \$2M \$4M per year for Alexandria
- Projects that reduce emissions and improve air quality
- Operating Costs for Initial 3 Years of New/Expanded Service
- Transportation Demand Management

Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP)

- \$1M \$3M per year for Alexandria
- Improve or preserve transportation infrastructure
- Research & Studies
- Bike/Ped Improvements, Trails, ADA, Transit, Smart Mobility
- Transportation Demand Management

FY 2031Funding Application for 2 projects



Safe Routes to School (Up to \$2M)

- 17 School Walk Audits
- 331 Recommendations
 - 172 have not yet begun
- Capital intensive "long term" recommendations
 - Examples: sidewalks, curb extensions, raised crosswalks





Citywide Bus Bulbs (Up to \$3.5M)



- ADA access
- Space for Amenities
 - Shelters, benches, etc.
- Improve bus travel times



DRPT State Aid Requests

- Operating Assistance (up to \$40M)
 - State awards a portion for general operating expenses
 - Typically, 20 -30% reimbursement
 - Avg: \$5m Annually
- Capital Assistance (up to \$24.2M)
 - Electric Buses, Roof Deck, Hybrid Spare Parts
 - Typically, 60 -68% reimbursement
- Commuter Assistance Program (up to \$200K)
 - Go Alex staffing and programming
 - 20% local match required





DRPT State Aid Requests

- Workforce Development (up to \$110K)
 - 2 Interns/apprentices
 - 20% local match required
- Demonstration Project (up to \$100K)
 - Digital Mirror
 - 20% local match required
- TRIP (up to \$650K)
 - Improving bus stops with shelters, benches, ADA improvements, etc.
 - Free WMATA Student fares
 - 32% local match required





DRPT State Aid Requests

- Technical Assistance Grant (up to \$100K)
 - CAP Strategic Plan and Baseline Data
 Collection for TMP Program
 - 50% local match (could use GO Alex funds)





