




City Hall and Market Square Timeline

. 1749

City of Alexandria was Founded

1752

Alexandria's First Town Hall was opened

1753

Opening of Alexandria Farmers Market 1817

The Tower designed by Benjamin Latrobe was added to City Hall 1871

City Hall was destroyed by a fire, new construction started shortly after to replace the original building

1873

Reconstruction of City Hall designed by Adolph Clauss was completed 1887-1895

City Hall undergoes 4 renovations to interior and exterior spaces of the building

- 1960-1961

The Original Ushaped building with a central countyard was filled in and replaced with a new building facing King Street 1963

City Hall approves budget to begin construction of Market Square and the underground parking garage

- Provide shade and functionality; create outdoor rooms

















