Program and design differences between Park Design Options 1 and 2

Parking	Parking largely remains as is, at existing location, with the addition of a one-way entrance.	Parking is relocated farther from a busy intersection, offering a more welcoming user experience by allowing visitors to view park activities from a vantage point. Additionally, Option 2 provides overflow parking spaces if needed.
Playground and Parkour	This option places the playground and parkour area in the southwest corner of the site at a higher elevation.	This option situates the playground near Duke Street at a lower elevation.
Open Lawn	This option offers a larger contiguous open lawn area with a loop trail	This option features more linear open space located along the southern side of the park, with some trail connectivity
Loop Trails	More loop trails	Less loop trails
Program/Amenities Placement	Programs and amenities are scatter across throughout the park.	Programs and amenities are clustered closer to Duke Street.

- Option 1 includes two basketball courts, while Option 2 features only one basketball court.
- Option 1 parking largely remains as is, with the addition of a one-way entrance. Option 2 relocates
 parking farther from a busy intersection, offering a more welcoming user experience by allowing
 visitors to view park activities from a vantage point. Additionally, Option 2 provides overflow parking
 spaces if needed.
- **Option 1** places the playground and parkour area in the southwest corner of the site at a higher elevation, whereas **Option 2** situates the playground near Duke Street at a lower elevation.
- **Option 1** offers a significantly larger open lawn area, while **Option 2** features a smaller open space tucked into the southwest corner of the site.
- Option 1 includes more loop trails compared to Option 2.
- Option 1, programs and amenities are scatter across throughout the park. In contrast, Option 2 clusters programs and amenities closer to Duke Street.
