

WHAT IS RAPID REHOUSING?

The goal of Rapid Rehousing is simple: help people experiencing an economic or housing crisis move into homes as quickly as possible. The City of Alexandria's Partnership to Prevent and End Homelessness partners with local non-profit agencies to provide short-term grant assistance for eligible individuals to pay rent and moving costs and provide services through evidence-based practices and case management strategies in order to achieve housing stability within 90 days.

RAPID REHOUSING NEEDS LANDLORDS!

Landlords are an essential part of Rapid Rehousing. You are a valuable resource to help combat housing and economic crises in our area. In order to provide new housing opportunities to those who need it, the partnership needs landlord partners with available units.

Becoming a landlord partner is easy. If you are a property owner or manager, just let us know you are interested and able to meet the below requirements:

- Able to provide a habitable living space for tenants
- Able to provide or use a written lease
- Willing to sign agency agreements for tenant assistance
- Willing to accept reasonable rent in according to Fair Market Rent standards
