PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The City of Alexandria is increasing the size of sanitary sewer pipes to reduce sanitary sewer back-ups at four locations in Rosemont and Del Ray: 200 and 300 blocks of E. Oak St., the unit and 100 blocks of E. Maple St., 500 block of E. Alexandria Ave., and 300 block of Ashby St.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

Monday - Saturday:

- Construction will take place in segments to minimize disruptions.
- Parking is restricted during construction hours for the full block under construction. Some parking may be restricted for the duration of the project due to material and equipment storage.
- Each morning, construction crews will knock on the doors of residences in the segments under construction that day and issue a reminder to limit sewage discharge during cutover periods.
- Construction crews will then disconnect the sanitary sewer laterals (pipes) for the homes impacted by the current work segment from the existing sewer system and connect them to the new sewer line. Note: the disconnection will occur <u>after</u> 9 a.m. and is anticipated to take approximately one hour.
- Crew members will knock on the doors of impacted homes again to inform residents once the cutover process is complete and it is safe to use the sewer system again.
- Crews will cover and secure all excavated roadway and reopen the road to traffic.
- This same notification process is repeated each day.
- Final repaying will come when all locations have been completed.
