Medication & Therapy

We provide medication and therapy services to help clients cope with past and current substance use, as well as helping people through the process of withdrawal and recovery.

Peer Support Services

Our Peer Support Program offers an environment where individuals find strength, understanding, friendship and a listening ear from others who have walked their own path of recovery. Peers work with you side-by-side to navigate this new journey.

Am I Eligible?

Call 703.746.3610 to complete a screening to determine eligibility. To be eligible, you must be a resident of the City of Alexandria and complete an intake assessment.

What if I'm not Eligible?

If you are not eligible, we will provide resources and telephone numbers for other locations and providers.

What if I'm Pregnant?

We welcome and prioritize pregnant women and encourage them to contact us. Early treatment and prenatal care are essential to increase positive pregnancy outcomes.

I'm Eligible What's Next?

After the initial screening and completion of your assessment, you will be scheduled to complete admission paperwork and to meet with medical staff for a physical exam. Previous clients who have been in services within the last 2 years are eligible for readmission with positive or negative drug test results.

Do I need to see a counselor?

Our program includes individual and group therapy services. You will meet with our therapists who will help you determine what groups will work best for you. Our therapists will help you explore your condition and begin to build recovery skills.

Do I have to come everyday?

Initially when you start you will need to come in daily. Rules do apply to take-home services and will be discussed. Your therapist can review eligibility to receive take-home medication.

Dosing Schedule:

Our comprehensive dosing schedule allows patients to manage their medication effectively by offering options for early morning, daily routines, weekends and take-home doses. Contact us for further details and personalized guidance.
