

OPIOID TREATMENT PROGRAM

Evidence-based medication and therapeutic services for opioid use disorders
Department of Community and Human Services

The Opioid Treatment Program (OTP) serves Alexandria residents aged 18 and older by providing safe medications to help control withdrawal symptoms while stopping the use of heroin, synthetic opiates, or misused prescription drugs. OTP clinicians prescribe and monitor individuals receiving Methadone and Buprenorphine (Suboxone) daily. Services also include treatment planning, individual and group therapy, and peer support groups. Cost is determined by a sliding scale or paid by insurance. Priority admission is given to pregnant and post-partum women, people using intravenously, and individuals with HIV/AIDS.
