APS eliminated 30 positions from their Chief Academic Office

ACPS eliminated vacant custodian and head custodian positions in accordance with its attrition plan

*FCPS There are currently hourly salaried positions that support the FCPS Food and Nutrition Services (FNS) program. This includes positions such as food service workers, food kitchen managers, food production assistants, temporary substitute food service workers, van drivers, and hourly central office positions. By not including these positions in the total food service FTE it skews the number of students per dept staff ratio.
