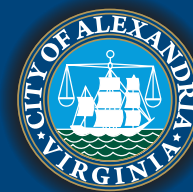

## Incentives and Opportunities

### Hiring Incentives and Tax Credits

The Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC) is designed to help move people from welfare into gainful employment, and obtain on-the-job experience. The WOTC helps American workers with barriers to employment prepare for sustainable jobs; ease their transition from job to job, benefit from creating effective regional economic development strategies; and create high performance workplaces. ### Training Opportunities

Training improves worker retention and productivity, and can keep your business competitive in a global environment. We can assist with customized training options. Funding is contingent upon program eligibility.

- Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) training funds
- Training for people with disabilities receiving Supplemental Security Income (SSI) & Supplemental Security
- Special Incentives for re-training and hiring veterans
- SNAPET and VIEW Employment Program

## Options and Recruitment

### Rapid Response to Mass Layoffs and Plant Closings

Employers who are laying off 50 or more workers are eligible for assistance from WDC through the Rapid Response Program.

### Federal Bonding Program

Persons with prior criminal convictions may be eligible for the Federal Fidelity Bond insurance, which is issued free-of-charge to the potential employer enabling the delivery of bonding services as a job placement tool. Upon making an offer of employment, the job seeker may contact WDC to assist with attaining a bond.

### Recruitment Process
