



- Local street with adjacent mixed uses and highdensity residential
- 3 of 4 approaches are currently stop controlled, creating confusion about who has the right-of-way



- Request for safety improvements through Alex311










 Proposed NTOR restrictions for vehicles turning from Fern Street onto N Quaker Lane
