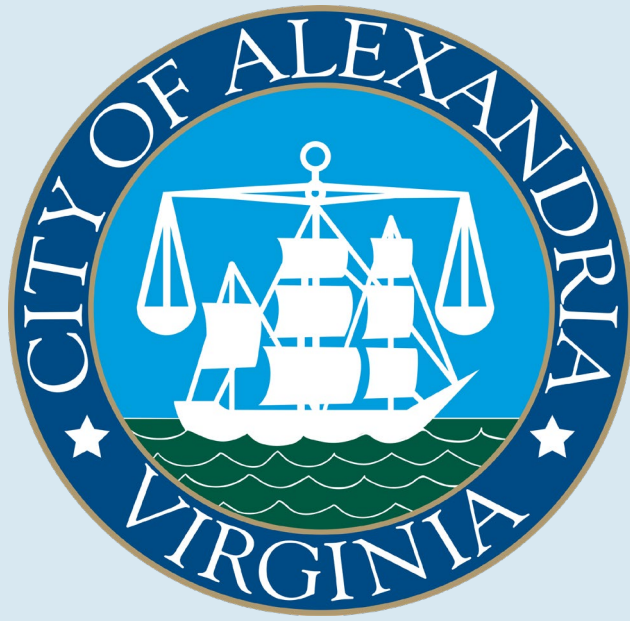

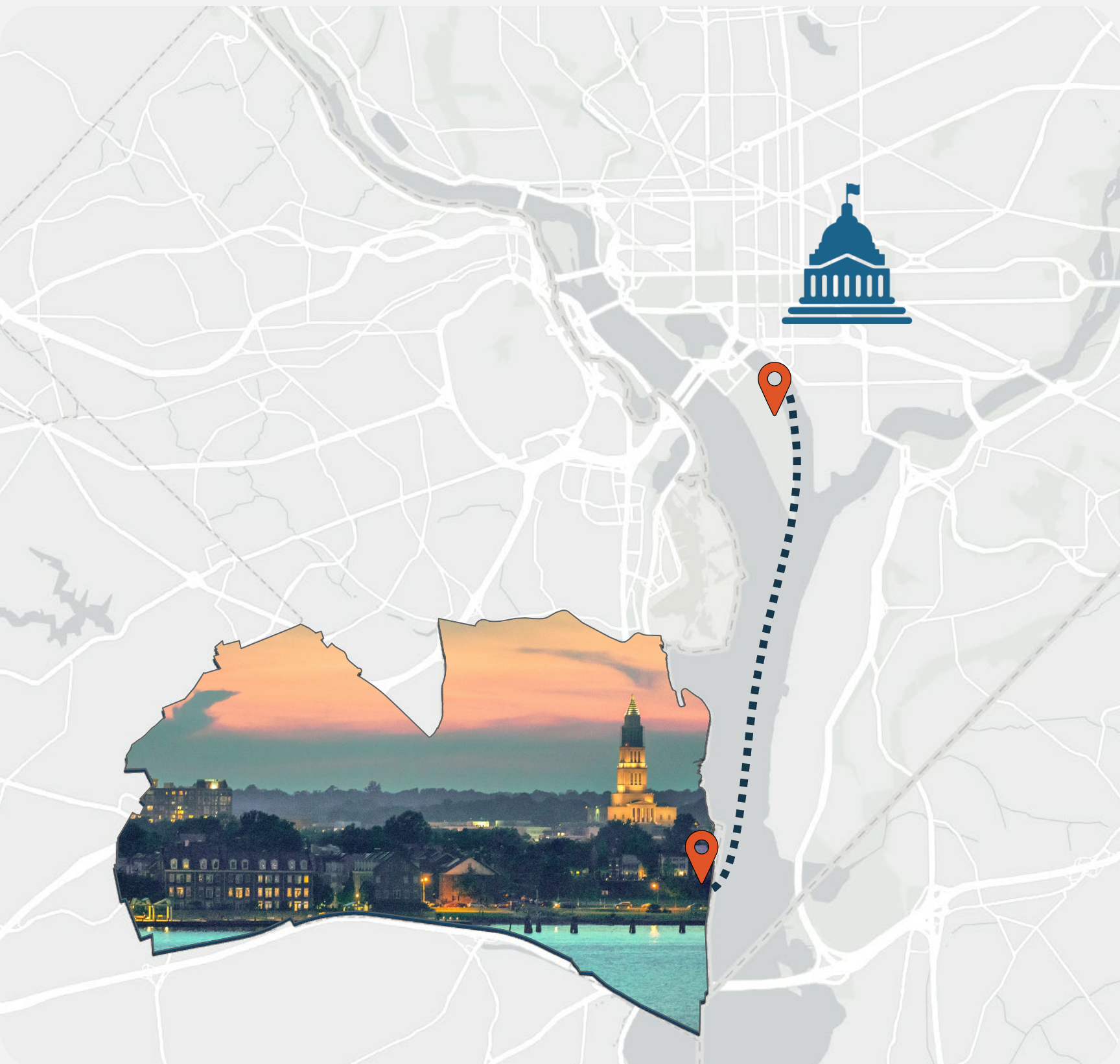

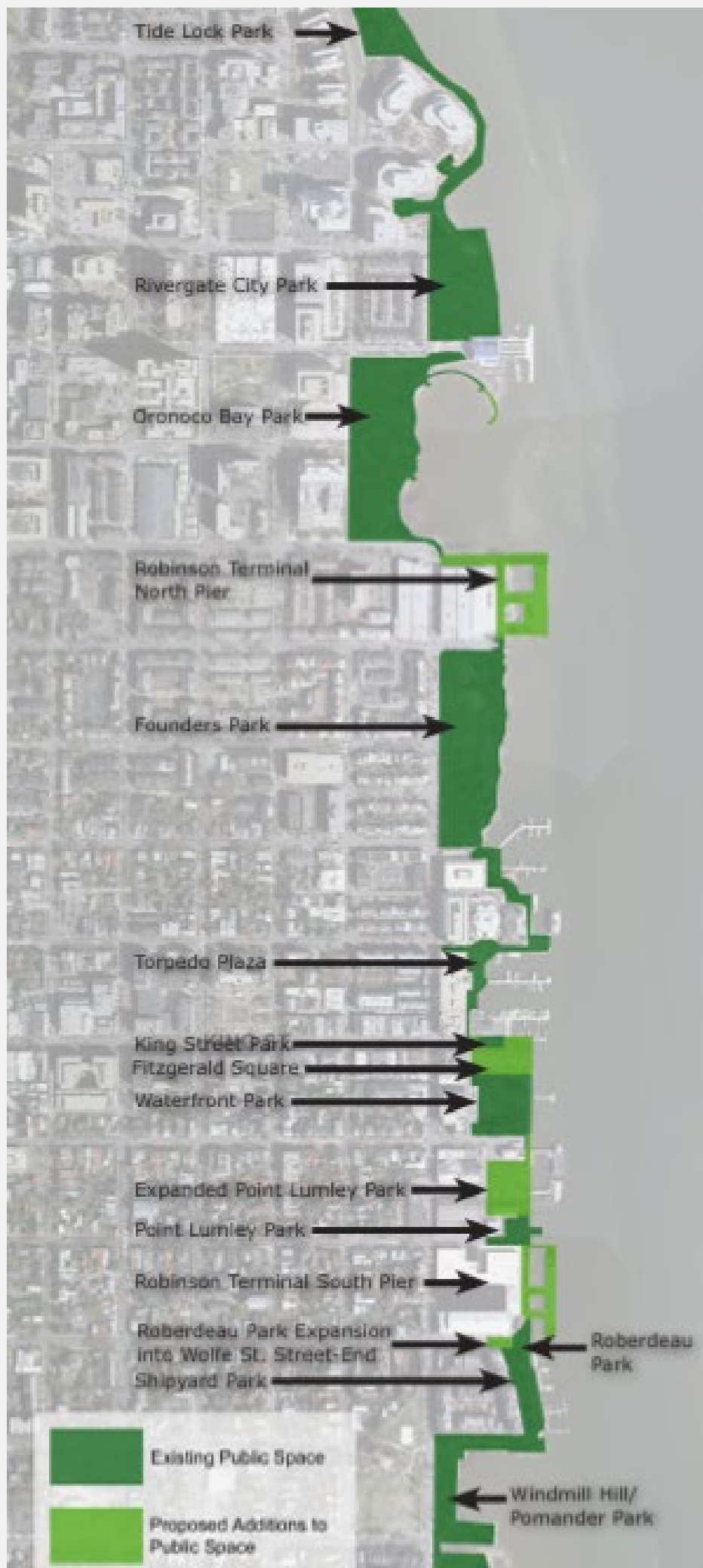


Evolution of Alexandria's Waterfront

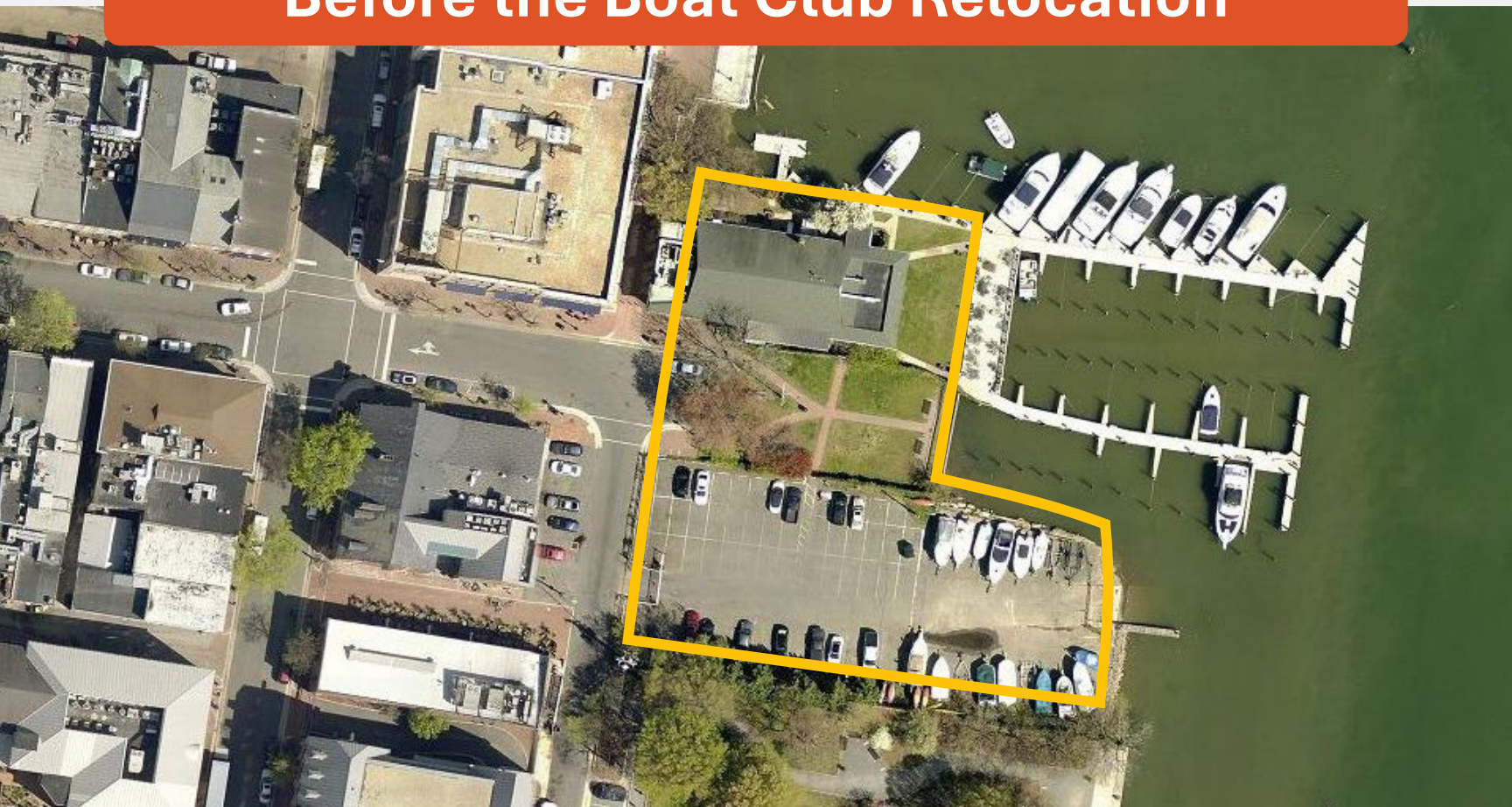

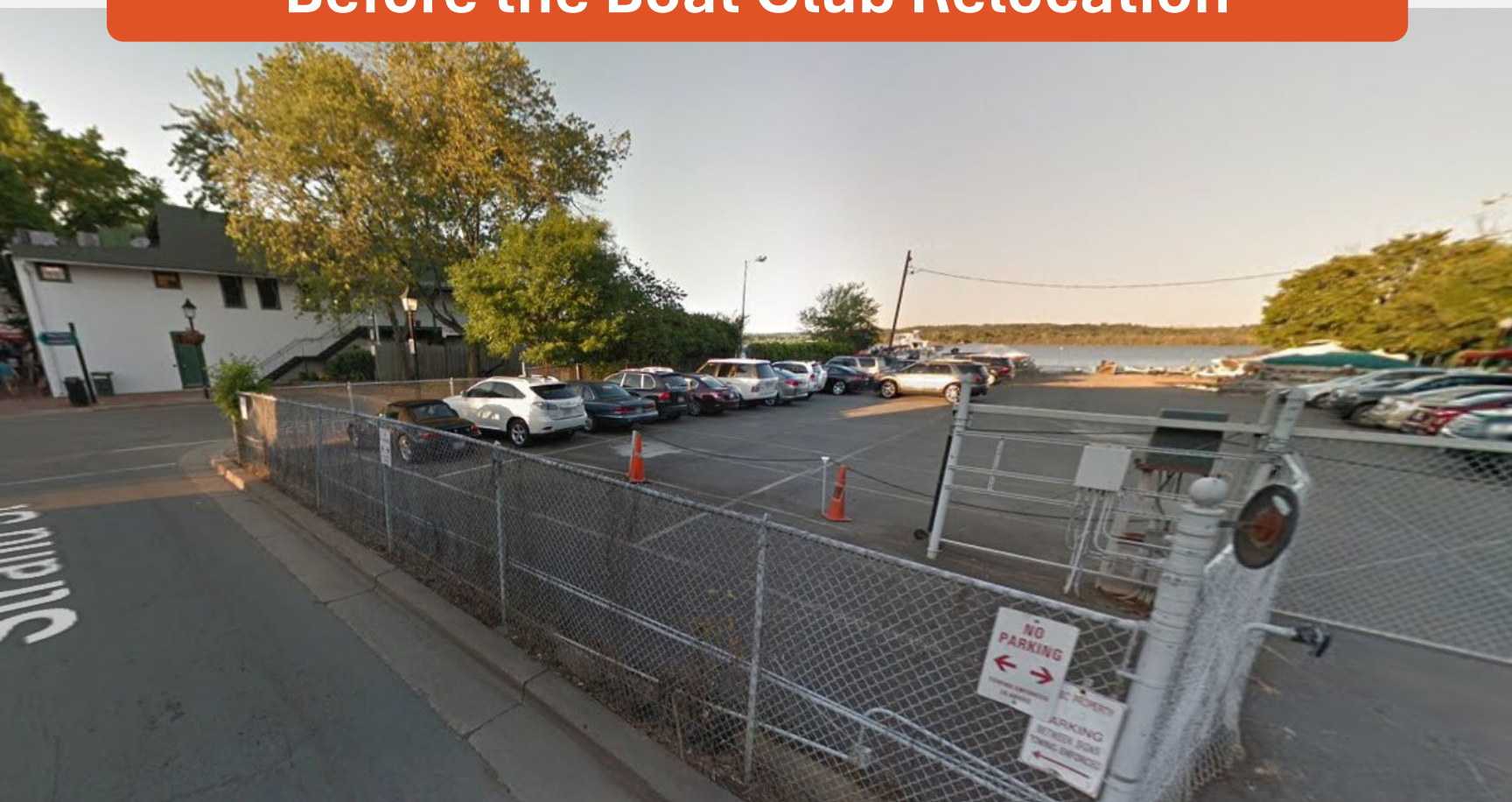

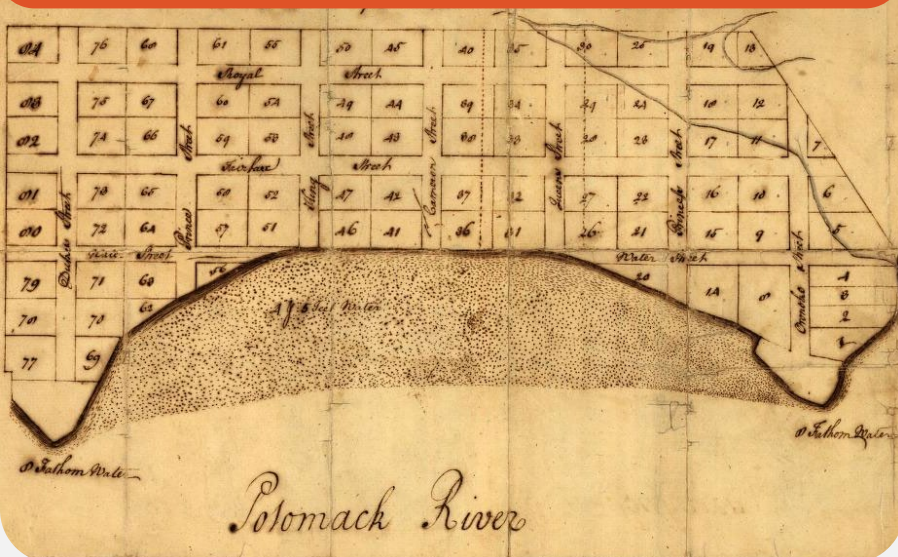


Flood Mitigation

Alexandria's historic shoreline was comprised of 15-20' bluffs that stood about two blocks inland from the current shoreline. Over time, this area was leveled and filled.

- Improve public access & amenities



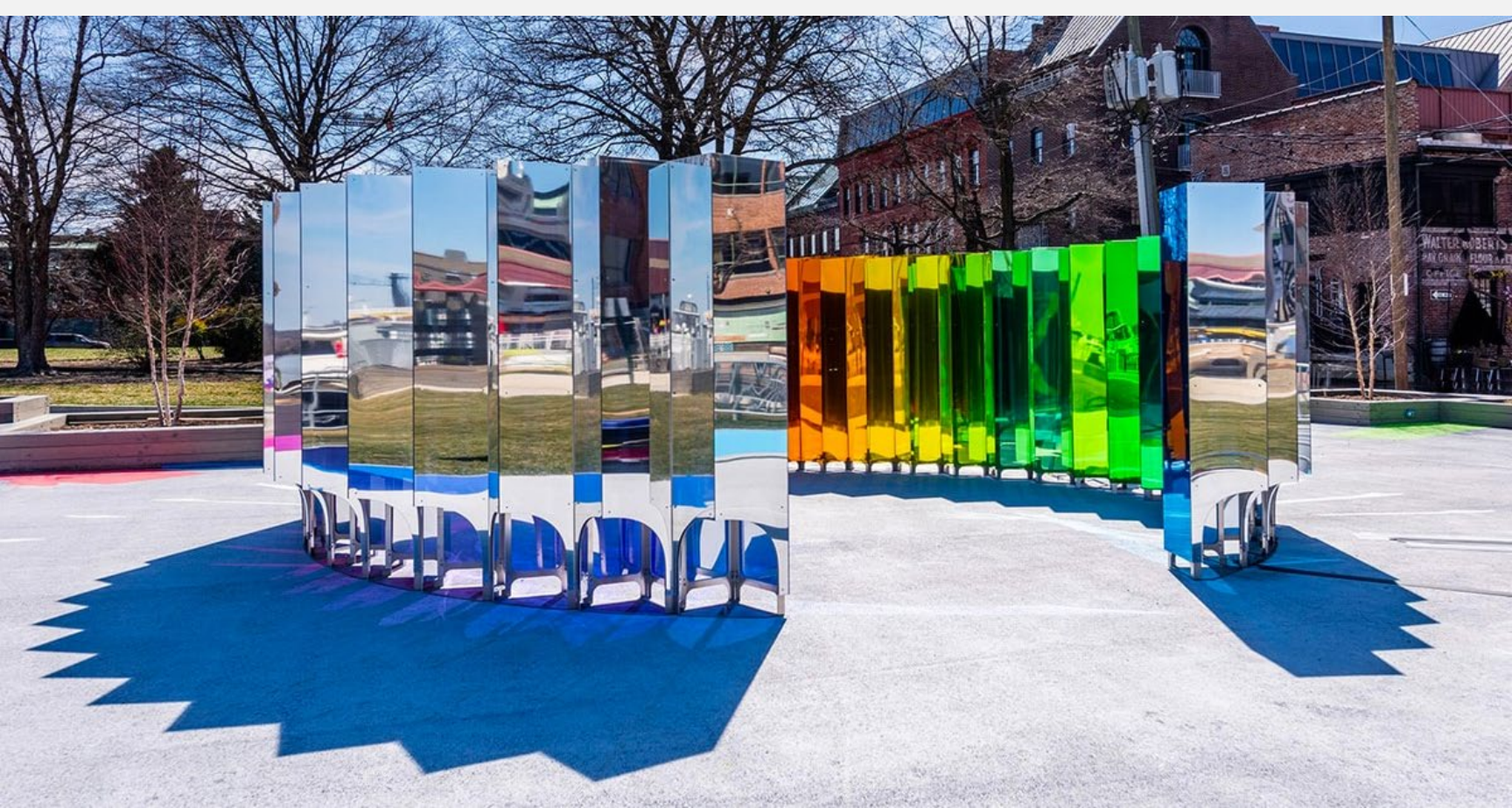

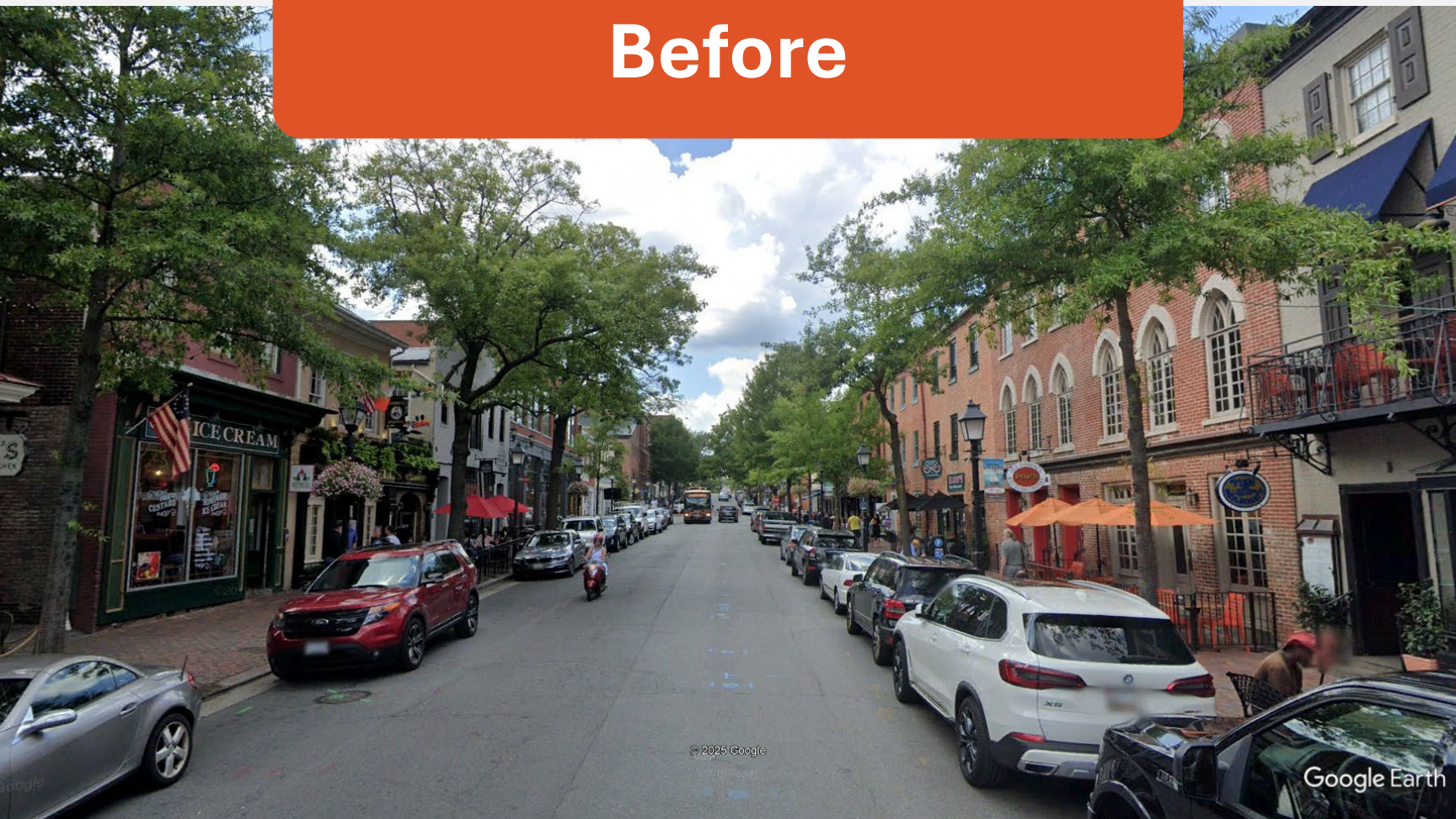

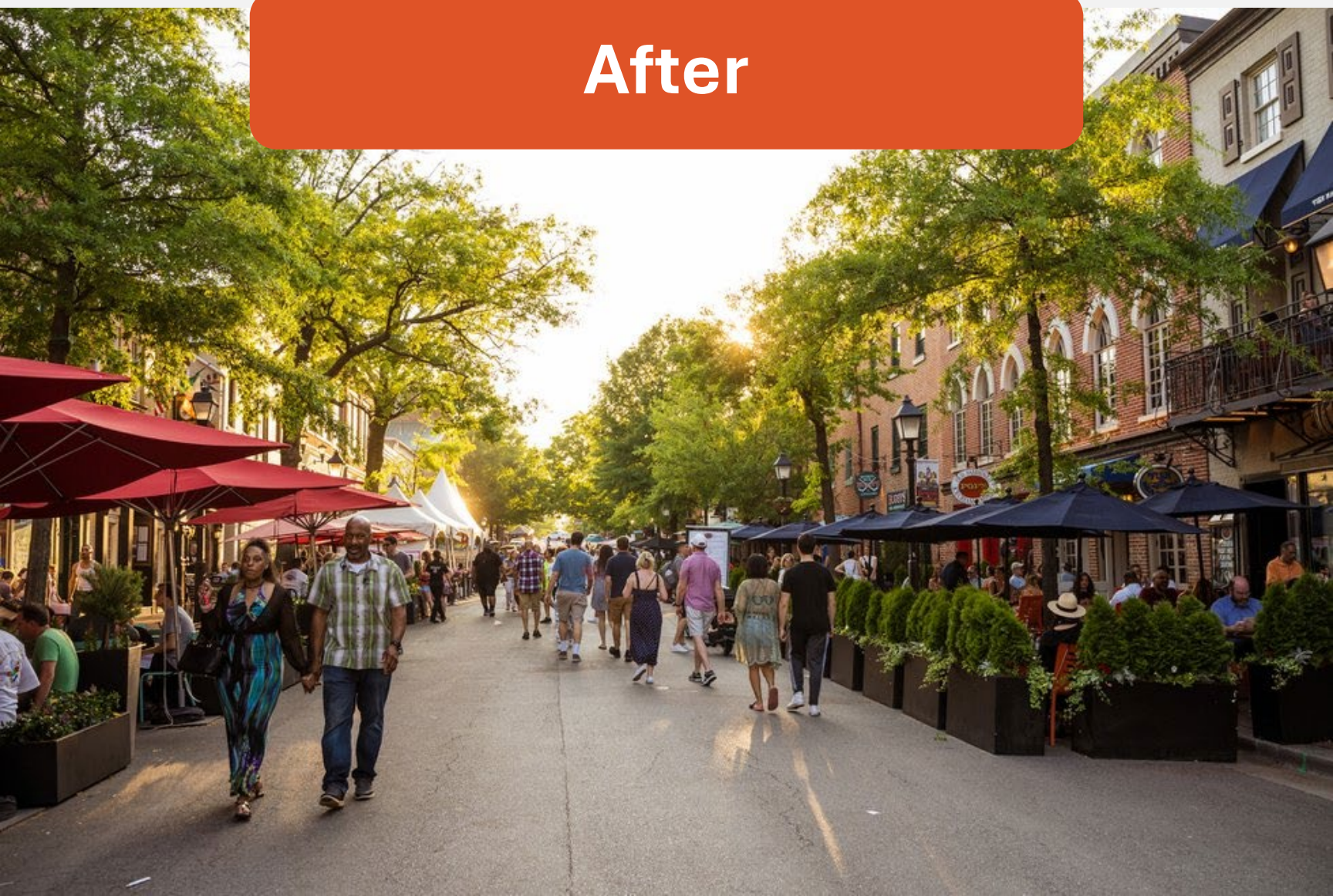
