- 1. Audrey Davis called the meeting to order at 5:39.
- 2. The August 8th Remembrance Event for Benjamin Thomas was discussed. Speaker is historian Steven Hahn. It will be at Shiloh Baptist at 6:30 and the format will include a student to provide context, a 10-15 minute keynote followed by interview style questions. We also hope to have a book signing following the speech.

3. Project Updates

- Faith Initiative Affirmation Statement will be delivered in the form of an open letter to City Council on Saturday morning, June 14 during public comment.
- Remembrance Student 2025-2026 plan and budget needs –
 presentation of plan to have three field trips and an April showcase.
 Need to raise \$7,000 over the summer for this program.
