Dear Community Member:

The City of Alexandria would like to inform you that construction on the sidewalk and layby lane along East Abingdon Drive north of Slaters Lane is scheduled to begin on August 18, weather permitting.

Here are some helpful details about what to expect during construction:

- Construction Schedule: August 18 October 3, weather permitting
- Work Hours: Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.; Saturday, 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- Road Closures:
 - During Construction Hours: Closure of East Abingdon Drive between Slaters Lane and the George Washington Memorial Parkway (G.W. Parkway)
 - Outside Construction Hours: Closure of the two right lanes on East Abingdon Drive between Slaters Lane and the G.W. Parkway. (Left lane will remain open.)
 - Ongoing: The right lane on East Abingdon Drive between Bashford Lane and Slaters Lane will be closed for the duration of the project.

• Sidewalk/Trail Closures:

o **Trail Detour:** The sidewalk and trail access point north of Slater's Lane will be closed for the duration of the project. People walking and biking through the area are advised to use the Mount Vernon Trail to avoid going through the pedestrian detour.

• Other Impacts:

- o Temporary relocation of the WMATA bus stop to the south side of the East Abingdon Drive and Slaters Lane intersection.
- o Parking will be prohibited on Slaters Lane adjacent to 615 Slaters Lane.
- o Northbound G. W. Parkway will be accessible via a right turn from westbound Slaters Lane during construction hours.
