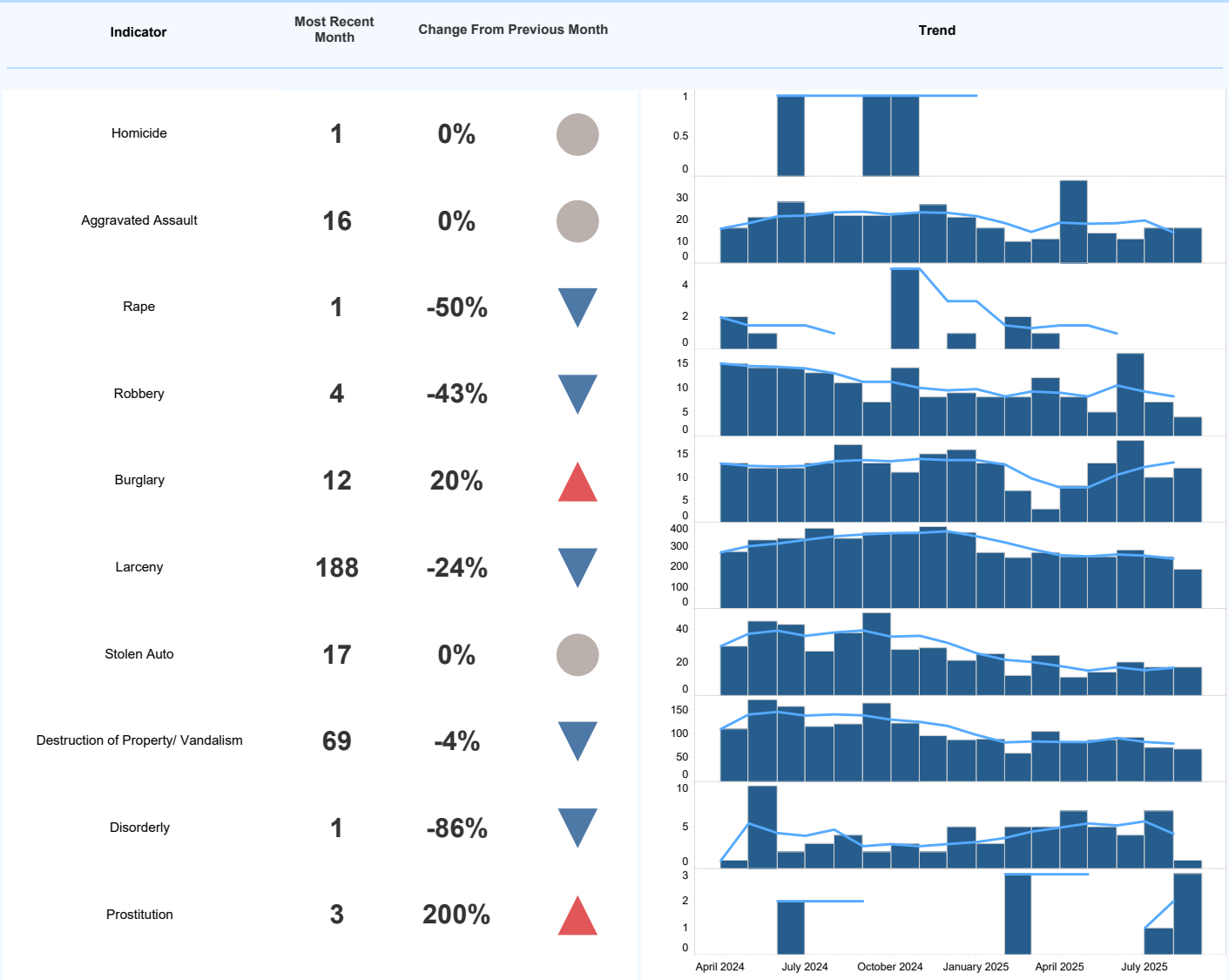

Crime Year to Date Situational Awareness



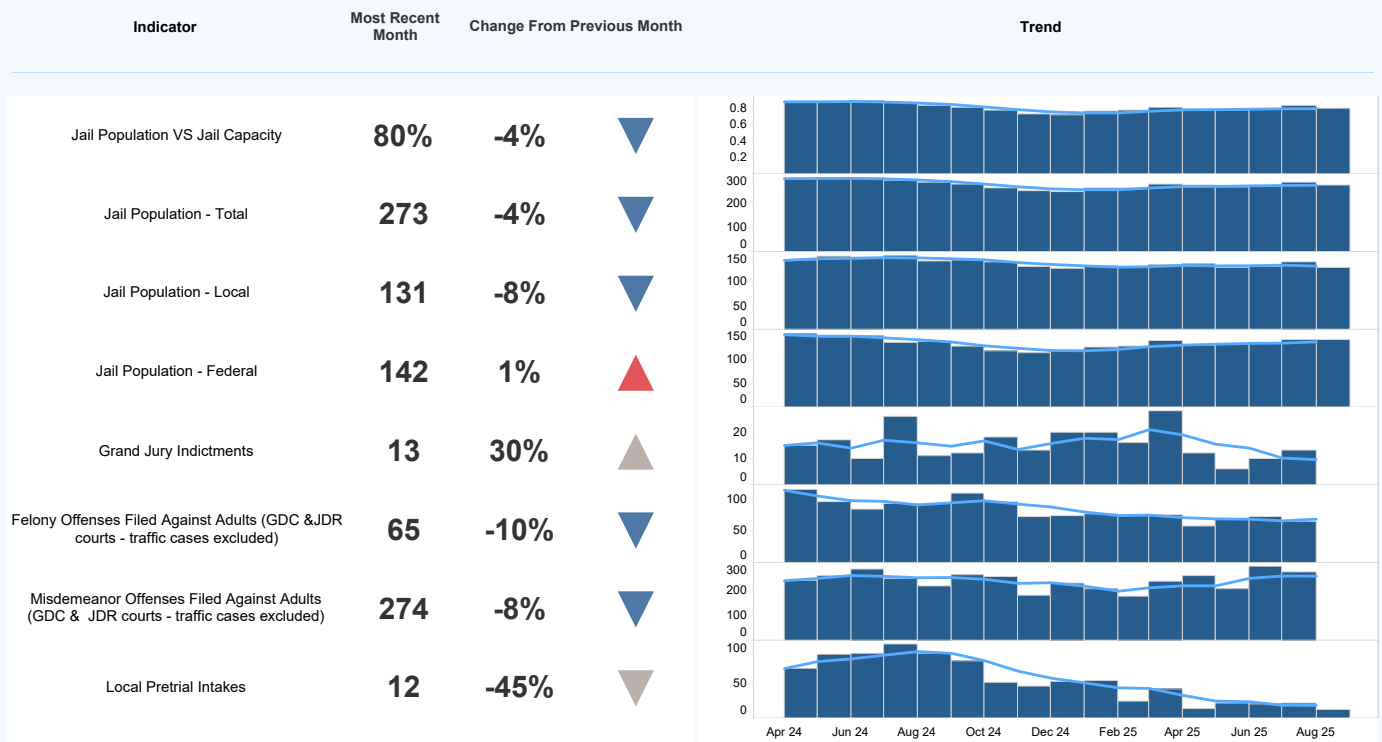
