












New Virginia School Accountability Systems

Virginia's Accreditation System Eight Components of SOA, including **Comprehensive School Identification** Accreditation Accreditation Fully Conditionally Accredited Accredited Denied Solely to meet state statutory obligations and focused on operational compliance





Accountability



Components

Mastery: how students are meeting academic standards (reading, math, science) and making progress in English language proficiency

Growth: how students are progressing academically over time

Readiness: how schools are preparing students for what's next



PERFORMANCE CATEGORIES

Distinguished

Schools are exceeding the state's expectation for growth, achievement, and readiness.

90 points and above

Key Differences

New System: Virginia School Performance & Support Framework	Old System: School Accreditation
School performance based on student mastery AND growth, individually.	School performance based on student mastery OR growth
Mastery measured by index and point system	Mastery measured by percentage of students passing
