Resolution of Readiness

Alexandria Police Community Review Board October____, 2025

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria has established the Independent Community Policing Review Board ("the Board") pursuant to the City Code, Title 2, Chapter 4,, Article AA, Section 2-4-220 *et seq.*, to provide independent civilian oversight of policing policies, practices, procedures, investigations, and outcomes; and

WHEREAS, the Board's mission includes conducting impartial reviews of investigations into complaints of police misconduct; reviewing and evaluating the Alexandria Police Department's policies, practices, procedures, and outcomes; issuing corrective recommendations intended to remedy discriminatory practices, including racial and social inequities; and fostering transparency and community trust; and

WHEREAS, to fulfill this mission, the Board must be organizationally prepared, adequately trained, and properly resourced to perform its duties effectively and with integrity;

WHEREAS, under City Code Section 2-4-227, the Board must pass a resolution of readiness before it can begin receiving questions, concerns, or comments about Alexandria Police Department employees or reviewing investigations of complaints of possible misconduct by those employees;

WHEREAS, the Board is authorized to pass this resolution of readiness only after ithas adopted internal rules of procedure; completedrequired training in police practices, constitutional law, due process, and civil rights; and established clear communication protocols with the, the Police Department;

WHEREAS, the Board has now completed all prerequisites to the passage of the readiness resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes that its legitimacy and effectiveness depend upon its preparedness, transparency, and good-faith engagement with both the community and the Police Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Alexandria Police Community Review Board hereby declares its readiness to:

1. Conduct its oversight duties and all its other duties and responsibilities consistent with the authority and scope granted by City Code, ensuring impartiality, fairness, and accountability;

3. Implement procedures for timely, thorough, and independent review of complaints, investigations, and practices of the Alexandria Police Department; Maintain a

- collaborative working relationship with the Independent Policing Auditor and relevant City officials to ensure alignment of oversight functions;
- 4. Provide regular reports and updates to the City Council and the public, in furtherance of transparency, trust, and accountability;and
- 5. Commit to ongoing training, policy review, and community engagement to strengthen its capacity to carry out its mission.
