


### **District Waterways Advisory Commission**

Office of District Waterways Management

#### 14 Voting Members appointed by the Mayor & Chairman of the Council

- (7) Appointed by the Mayor:
  - Public safety;
  - Environmental stewardship;
  - Economic development or tourism;
  - Maritime management or policy;
  - Athletics and recreation; and
  - Maritime transportation.
- (7) Appointed by the **Chairman of the Council**:
  - Two ANC representatives;
  - Two BID representatives;
  - Two marina or yacht club representatives; and
  - An individual with expertise or interest in waterway management.





### **District Waterways Advisory Plan**

Office of District Waterways Management

- 1. The orderly, safe, and efficient use of the waterways for <u>boating and</u> recreation;
- 2. <u>Public and private uses of property</u> and <u>infrastructure adjacent</u> to the waterways;
- Interagency and regional coordination on issues relevant to the waterways, and adjacent property;
- 4. Environmental conservation and management;
- 5. Strategies for coordinated economic growth
- 6. Assessments of safety and security risks and needs;
- 7. Identification of <u>transportation gaps</u> on and adjacent to the waterways; and
- 8. Opportunities to increase local control.
