Ms. Lyman called the Board Meeting to order at 6:59 P.M.

### I. EXECUTIVE SESSION

 The meeting was called to an Executive Session by Mary Lyman and seconded by Lamuel Houston Jr. at 7:04 P.M. to discuss a personnel matter and ended the Executive Session at 7:20 P.M. to resume the public meeting.

#### II. PUBLIC COMMENT

### III. CONSENT ACTION ITEMS

 Approval of October 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025, Board Minutes: On a motion by Mary Lyman, seconded by Michele Walz, the Board unanimously approved the minutes of the October 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

### IV. DISCUSSION ITEMS

- Chontelai Patterson-Mendie shared the Alexandria DCHS (CSB) Quarterly Incident Report Analysis covering July 1, 2025- September 30, 2025
- Ms. Patterson-Mendie stated that Q3 2025 had relatively the same number of serious incidents as Q2 2025, only decreasing slightly from 87 to 86 serious incidents.
- Ms. Patterson-Mendie also stated that although Q2 and Q3 2025 appear to have similar data, Level I serious incidents have increased by 11% and Level II serious incidents have decreased by -76% between these Quarters.

- Additionally, Ms. Patterson-Mendie highlighted that there were 2 Level III serious
  incidents in Q3 2025 and that Level III serious incidents can occur in or outside the
  CSB's provision of a service and can occur on or off the CSB's premises
- Ms. Patterson-Mendie also shared the Risk Management Plan for 2025. Mrs.
  Patterson-Mendie added that the Alexandria CSB defines Risk Management as the
  act of controlling any threats to the organization's: goodwill, people, property,
  income, and ability to accomplish goals.
- Ms. Patterson-Mendie emphasized that risk management is a continuous process
  that involves a comprehensive analysis of potential exposures, mitigation strategies
  and monitoring while the goal of the plan is to identify potential exposures and
  attempt to mitigate or avoid the potential risks.
- Ms. Patterson-Mendie reviewed Alexandria DCHS (CSB) Board Policies #11-20 and shared that there were no changes.

# V. <u>EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR COMMENTS/CONCERNS</u>

- Federico Gutierrez reported that City Manager has called for 1% reduction for the DCHS budget which amounts to an estimated \$612,000.
- Mr. Gutierrez added that senior staff across DCHS collaborated on a budget plan that will be presented to the City Manager on December 5<sup>th</sup>, 2025.
   Mr. Gutierrez presented the results of a claims audit conducted by Optum last December.
