

How to Get There and Transit Options

Driving

A four-level parking garage is adjacent to the rear of the building with elevator access to the building lobby.


Free Parking is available for clients, City employees and visitors.

Validation of the ticket
is only required after 4 hours.

Public Transit

Mark Center is a **five-minute walk** from the Mark Center Transit Station.

Can be accessed through routes on the **Metrobus** and the **free DASH Bus**.

Paratransit

The **Alexandria DOT Paratransit** program provides curb to curb transportation for residents who cannot use public transportation due to disability.

Residents using the DOT service can be **dropped off at the front entrance** to the building in the drop-off zone.
