FELONY JURY TRIALS MAY START ON THE FOLLOWING DAYS OF THE WEEK

Until further notice, the following guidance shall be followed when scheduling a felony jury trial.

MONDAY: All Mondays

Maximum: 2 new or carryover criminal jury trials

TUESDAY: 1st, 2nd, 4th or 5th Tuesday of the month

Maximum: 2 new or carryover criminal trials

TUESDAY: 3rd Tuesday of the month – TMAD (Traffic and Misdemeanor Appeals docket)

Reserved for misdemeanor jury trials; no new criminal jury trials may begin

WEDNESDAY: 2nd and 4th Wednesdays of the month (Civil Motions Day)

2 carryover criminal jury trials; no new criminal jury trials may begin

WEDNESDAY: 1st, 3rd and 5th Wednesdays of the month (if not a Civil Motions Day)

Maximum: 2 new or carryover criminal jury trials

THURSDAY: 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th Thursdays of the month

Maximum: 1 carryover criminal jury trial; no new criminal jury trials may begin

THURSDAY: 1st Thursday of the month

Maximum: 2 new or carryover criminal jury trials

FRIDAY: All Fridays

Felony cases: Maximum: 2 carryover criminal jury trials

Motions: One slot may be used for criminal motions lasting more than 2 hours.
Motions lasting 2 hours or less shall be scheduled for a Regular CW Day docket.

Misdemeanor jury: If available, one slot may be used for a criminal misdemeanor jury trial only if **all** of the following Friday jury trial conditions are met:

- (1) Misdemeanor case only;
- (2) Scheduled 6 weeks in advance;
- (3) Estimated to last one day or less;
- (4) Maximum of 3 total witnesses total for both sides;
- (5) Maximum of 3 hours for evidence presentation; and
- (6) Jury deliberations estimated to start no later than 1:00 p.m. or shortly thereafter.
