UTILILTY WORK NOTICE – MAY 2023

100 Block of E. Raymond Ave.

This notice is to inform City of Alexandria Residents in immediate proximity of the intersection of E. Raymond Ave and Dewitt Ave. that utility location work is scheduled to be performed along the 100 Block of E. Raymond Ave.

The City has hired a contractor to collect information on the City's storm sewer system and streetscape in support of the 100 Hume Ave Stormdrain Bypass Project, which began design on August 1st, 2022.

The utility location work is scheduled to begin and end on May 15th, 2023, weather permitting. Work will occur during standard work hours and is expected to take no more than one full workday. The Contractor crews will use metal detectors to paint the location of buried utility lines to confirm their location. Never will contractor operations violate existing city noise and construction ordinances:

Construction work in the City of Alexandria is permitted from 7:00AM to 6:00PM Monday – Friday, and 9:00AM – 5:00PM on Saturday. No construction activity is permitted on Sundays.

No disturbances or impacts will be made to your private property.

No road closures are scheduled to support these efforts. Access to residential driveways within the work area will be maintained; however, street parking within the work area will be restricted for the duration of work. Please relocate any street parked vehicles prior to the start of work. As always, please be mindful of contractor crews working in or alongside the roadway.
