

Old Dominion Boulevard Safety Improvements Community Discussion

PROJECT BACKGROUND

This project responds to multiple community requests for pedestrian safety improvements in the neighborhood.

Residential Sidewalk Application:

- 100+ people supported a sidewalk application along the 3600 block of Old Dominion Blvd.
- A traditional sidewalk is not currently feasible due to right-of-way limitations and funding constraints.
- An interim on-street sidewalk is proposed as an implementable near-term solution.

Neighborhood Transportation Improvements Program Requests:

- Intersection safety improvements at Tennessee Avenue and North Overlook Drive
- Pedestrian crossing at Old Dominion Drive and Tennessee Avenue

These requests were combined into a single coordinated project due to overlapping geography and shared safety goals.

WHAT IS PROPOSED?

1. **Interim on-street sidewalk facility** (creates the only dedicated pedestrian connection between W. Glebe Road and points south)
2. **New crosswalk** at Old Dominion Drive & Tennessee Avenue
3. **Intersection safety improvements** at Tennessee Avenue & North Overlook Drive (includes stop sign relocation (~20 feet) and daylighting)

DESIGN EVOLUTION & PARKING CONSIDERATIONS

We heard your concerns about parking and revised the design accordingly.

Parking Impact Comparison	
<i>Concept 1</i>	14 spaces removed
<i>Concept 2</i>	18 spaces removed
<i>Revised Concept</i>	10 spaces removed

Result: Preservation of 4–8 additional spaces compared to earlier concepts.

Revised Concept Parking Breakdown:

- 8 spaces removed for on-street sidewalk facility
 - 4 currently reserved from 6 a.m. – 1 p.m. on Sundays
 - 4 currently general public spaces
- 2 spaces removed for intersection improvements at Tennessee Avenue and North Overlook Drive
- 1 space removed for new crosswalk at Old Dominion Boulevard and Tennessee Avenue
- 1 space added in front of main entrance to BHCUMC

BENEFITS & TRADEOFFS

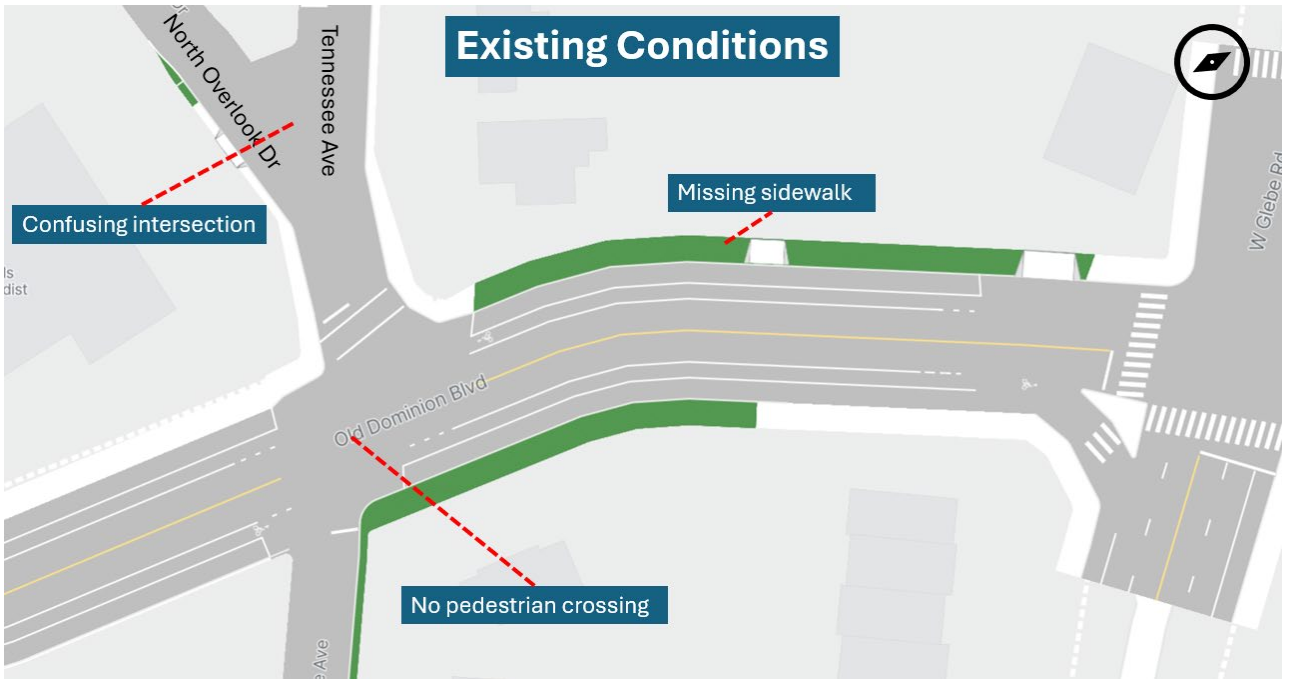
Benefits:

- Dedicated, safe pedestrian connection (W. Glebe Rd to points south)
- New marked crosswalk (Old Dominion Blvd & Tennessee Ave)
- Improved intersection safety (Tennessee Ave & N. Overlook Dr)
- Immediate implementation of safety improvements

Tradeoff:

- Removal of 10 on-street parking spaces
