

TOPIC

This survey will gather opinions about the cleanses and problems of school bathrooms.

TOPIC DESCRIPTION

Many students at school are affected by dirty or poorly maintained bathrooms. When bathrooms are not clean, students may avoid using them during the school day, which can make them uncomfortable and distracted in class. Broken stalls, bad smells, lack of soap, or trash on the floors can also create health and hygiene problems. This matters at ACHS and in Alexandria because students deserve a safe, clean, and respectful environment at school. Improving bathroom conditions can help students feel healthier, more comfortable, and more focused on learning.

BASELINE DATA & GOAL

7 out of 10 students say school bathroom are sometimes dirty or missing supplies.

1 goal is to reduce bathroom complaints by 50% by the end of the school year.

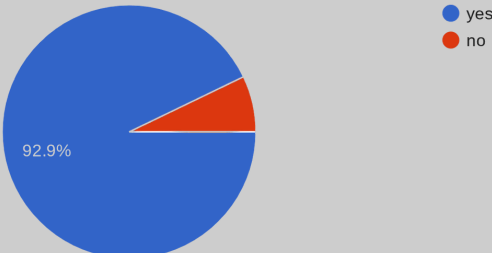
CYCP GOAL & STRATEGIC AREA

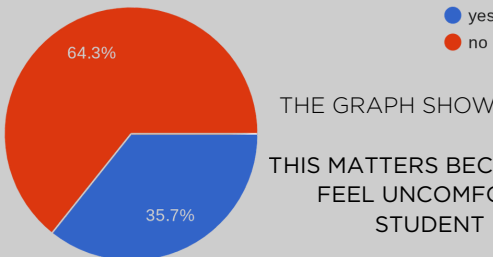
WHAT IS HAPPENING RIGHT NOW?

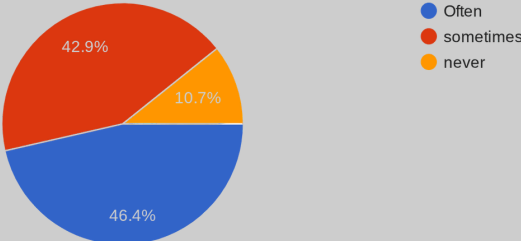
THE GRAPH SHOWS THAT 93.9% OF STUDENTS SAID THE BATHROOM STALLS WOK, WHILE ONLY A SMALL PERCENTAGE SAID THEY DO NOT WORK. THIS MATTER BECAUSE WOKING STALLS GIVE STUDENTS PRIVACY AND MAKE BATHROOMS MOE COMFORTABLE AND USABLE. EVEN THOUGH MOST STALLS WORK, THE FEW BROKEN STALLS CAN STILL CAUSE PROBLEMS FOR STUDENTS.

Are bathrooms clean?

THE GRAPH SHOWS THAT 64.3% OF STUDENTS SAID THE BATHROOMS ARE NOT CLEAN, WHILE ONLY 35.7% SAID THEY ARE CLEAN. THIS MATTERS BECAUSE DIRTY BATHROOMS CAN SPREAD GERMS AND MAKE STUDENTS FEEL UNCOMFORTABLE USING THEM. CLEAN BATHROOMS ARE IMPORTANT FOR STUDENT HEALTH, SAFETY, AND COMFORT DURING THE SCHOOL DAY.

How often do toilets appear unflushed or unusable in school bathrooms?

THE GRAPH SHOWS THAT 46.4% OF STUDENTS SAID TOILETS ARE OFTEN UNFLUSHED OR UNUSABLE, 42.9% SAID SOMETIMES, AND ONLY 10.7% SAID NEVER. THIS MATTERS BECAUSE UNUSABLE OR UNFLUSHED TOILETS CREATE UNSANITARY CONDITIONS AND MAKE IT HARDER FOR STUDENTS TO USE THE RESTROOM SAFELY. THE DATA SHOWS THIS IS A COMMON PROBLEM THAT STILL NEEDS IMPROVEMENT.

THE SCHOOL HAS JANITORS CLEAN BATHROOMS AND FIX BROKEN STALLS.THEY ARE ONLY PARTLY WORKING BECAUSE MANY STUDENTS STILL THINK BATHROOMS ARE DIRTY AND TOILETS ARE UNUSABLE.

WHAT HAS ALREADY BEEN TRIED?

The school has janitors clean bathrooms daily and repair broken stalls or toilets when needed. staff members also monitor bathrooms during the school day.

WHO CAN HELP?

School janitors/ custodians- they can clean bathrooms more often and quickly fix problems.

School administrators- they can create better bathroom rules and provide more supplies and maintenance.



WHAT HAS BEEN DONE SO FAR?

Bathrooms are cleaned regularly, broken stalls are repaired, and staff check bathrooms during the day.

IS IT ACTUALLY HELPING?

the actions are helping a little because most stalls work, but many students still think bathrooms are dirty and toilets are often unusable.

WHAT SHOULD CHANGE? (YOUR SOLUTION)

School bathrooms should be cleaner, safer, and fully stocked with supplies. The school can improve cleaning schedules, fix broken stalls quickly, and add ways for students to report problems. survey results showed many students think bathrooms are dirty or uncomfortable to use.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN NEXT?

cleaner bathrooms will help students feel safer and healthier at school. students, teachers and staff will all benefit from these changes.
