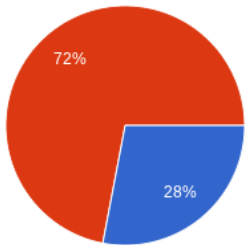
Increasing one on one support.

BASELINE DATA & GOAL

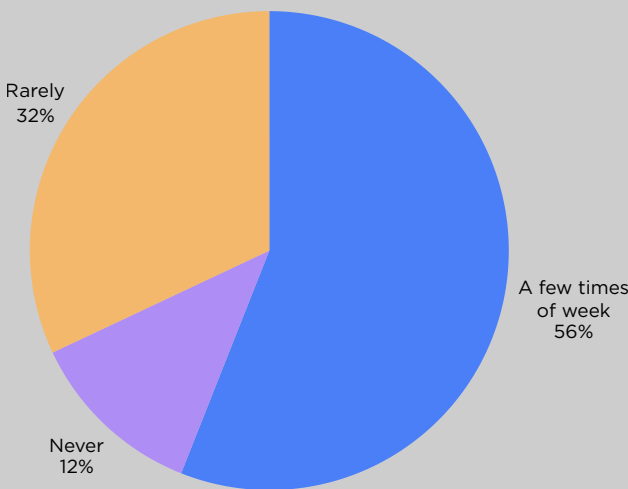

CYCP GOAL & STRATEGIC AREA

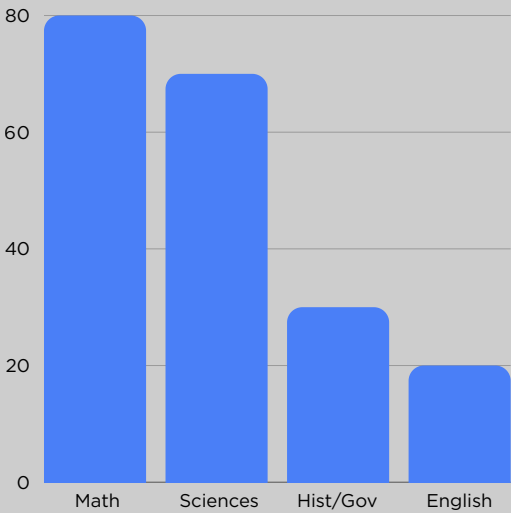
This issue connects to the academic success and students support goal because it focus on helping students improve their learning, grades and confidence.

WHAT IS HAPPENING RIGHT NOW?



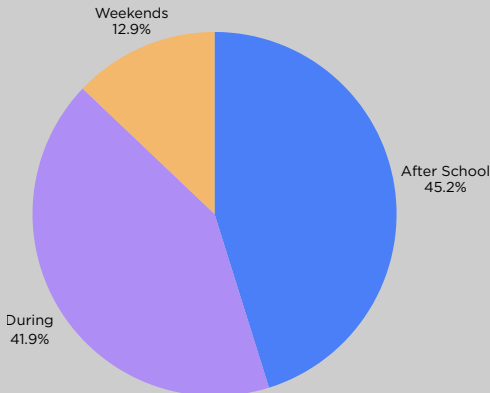
The data shows that 58% of students need extra help with homework a few times a week, while 32% rarely need helps and 12% never need help.

This matter because it shows that many students at ACHS need extra support to keep up with their homework and classes.



The data shows that students find math and science the most difficult subjects, with Math 80 % being the highest . History/ Government and English were reported as less difficult.

This matter because who struggle in difficult subjects may fall behind and need more one on one support to improve this grades.



The data shows that most students prefer to receive extra help after school, with 45.2% would like to receive extra help after school, another 41.9% of students prefer receiving help during help school.

This matter because it helps the school understand the best times to offer tutoring and one on one support. Offering help at the best time could allow more students to get the support they need.

WHAT HAS ALREADY BEEN TRIED?

ACHS and ACPS are already working to help students who need support on their work. ACPS is offers free 24 hours online tutoring, and also provides after school tutoring, study support programs. and teacher office hours for students who needs help.

WHO CAN HELP?

Casa chirilagua and Community lodging can help solve this issue by providing tutoring, mentoring, study support, and learning opportunities to help students improve their confidence and success in school



WHAT HAS BEEN DONE SO FAR?

School and community groups have offered peer tutoring programs , teacher office our, and online tutoring services to help students who need support assistance.

These programs have helped some students improve their grades and understanding, but many students still feel they do not receive enough one on one support,.

IS IT ACTUALLY HELPING?

ACHS has already created tutoring, support programs to help students succeed. These programs are helping some students, but the survey data shows that many students still need more support. Since 72% of students said they do not receive extra. Although support programs exist , not all students are receiving the help they need.

WHAT SHOULD CHANGE? (YOUR SOLUTION)

My solution is to increase one on one support at Alexandria city high school by offering more tutoring sessions, teacher office hour, and study support opportunities before or after school. Students could receive help personally or in small groups so they can better understand assignments, prepare for tests, and improve their grades. My survey data support this idea because 72% of students said they do not receive extra support, while 28% said they do. in addition 56% of students need extra help with homework a few times a week, and 50% said they would prefer to receive support after school.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN NEXT?

If my solution is used, students will receive more one on one support, which means students will improve their grades and understand in class.
